FEDERAL LEGISLATION

The Senate has yet to take action (as of March 4) on **S.220**, its version of the *Born-Alive Abortion Survivors Protection* Act, which the House has already passed. **HR.3354**, a broad funding bill, is "likely"

to get a vote this Spring. It bans both funds for elective abortions on ICE detainees, and funds for research on fetal tissue from abortions. It includes the *Conscience Protection* Act. It also nullifies the Wash., DC assisted suicide law, and a DC law (*RHNDA*) that could force pro-life groups to accept a pro-abortion employee.

The 10th Circuit Court of Appeals rejected a Kansas law that kept Medicaid funds from going to Planned Parenthood. This is the fifth time a court has nixed this kind of law. Recall that on Jan.19, HHS restored more flexibility to states, regarding Medicaid funds.

The new Chief of Staff for HHS's Office of Civil Rights is March Bell. He formerly worked for the House Select Panel on Infant Lives, which is probing alleged trade in aborted baby parts. Pro-abort Democrats sent a letter to HHS Head Alex Azar, charging Bell colluded with David Daleiden, who made the undercover PP videos. Judge Orrick, who presides over two of the suits against Daleiden, may be forced to recuse himself because of the Judge's long-term ties to a PP facility.

Encouraging words: Kristan Hawkins (Students for Life) stated, "You can't walk five feet" in the Dept. of Health and Human Services "without running into a prolifer."

Another case involving a pregnant, unaccompanied 14 year old, 'Jane Doe', is in the Courts. Her guardians, the US Office of Refugee Resettlement (ORR), asked that her lawyers' bid for a 'bypass' of Texas' parental consent law be removed to Federal District Court, since she no longer wants an abortion or her pro-abortion lawyers. The District Court said no; the case stays in State Court. ORR appealed to US 5th Circuit Court, which ordered Jane to come tell a Judge if she wants the abortion or not.

This sounds like a win, but the 5th Circuit also said, if Jane wants an abortion ORR must work with the chosen State guardians, meaning ORR is no longer her guardian. And the 5th Circuit said ORR is ignoring its federal duty by not taking Jane to the State Court 'bypass' hearing. A lone dissenting 5th Circuit Judge says the majority's logic violates the US Constitution's Supremacy Clause. Final Word: Courts will invert anything, to allow abortion.

After only 30 minutes, a Michigan jury found five "Red Rose Rescuers" guilty of trespass and obstruction. They were ordered to stay 150 yards from abortion facilities until sentencing March 14, and face a maximum \$500 fine, or 90 days in jail. Also, in DC Superior Court, Fr. Imbarrato, pleading not guilty, will have a hearing May 23, and face trial June 25, along with Julia Haag and Joan McKee. All Rescuers were released last Nov. [See LN, Nov '17, p3]

NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATION

Legislative action regarding Gov.
Cuomo's abortion expansion efforts is cur-

rently being considered in Albany. There will be an LICL lobby trip on 3/14, and a Legislative Day trip by other pro-life groups on 3/20. Both dates occur after this writing, so results will become known in later columns. We continue to fight against physician assisted suicide in the New York State Legislature which is a lethal threat to the elderly and disabled.

In the meantime, NY's fiercely pro-abortion Attorney General Eric Schneiderman has been dealt a blow in his efforts to silence pro-life witness at abortion mills in a lawsuit filed against them. U.S. District Judge Carol Bagley Amon told participants that leafletting is a "form of really protected speech" and that sidewalks are recognized as the "quintessential public forum." Schneiderman filed the lawsuit in June 2017 with the intent to shut down pro-life and Christian speech on public sidewalks outside an abortion facility in Jamaica, New York.

Ethical Issues - In Vitro Fertilization



Ethicist Wesley J. Smith wrote at First Things (10/27/17): "Whenever I write about the underregulated multi-billion-dollar infertility industry, I receive anguished emails from women who can't become pregnant, declaring that they "would do anything to have a baby." I can certainly empathize with their sadness, but their willingness to do *anything* is a problem. This deep and very human yearning has led to the development of technologies that are moving us away from the unconditional acceptance of the children we receive toward a perceived right to not only have a baby, but to have "the baby we want."

"When first invented, in vitro fertilization (IVF) was sold as a medical remedy to be limited to married couples who could not otherwise conceive. That moralistic restriction is long gone. Today, access to IVF has few limitations – and includes even women well beyond their natural childbearing years. Moreover, it is often combined with "preimplantation genetic diagnosis," in which a cell is removed from IVF embryos and tested for medical or eugenic failings – as well as for the sex – so that only embryos with desired attributes will be implanted. If too many embryos implant, the next step may be "selective reduction," the abortion of one or more gestating babies – or, as I once heard an industry rep put it, "turning triplets into twins." And what of the embryos deemed not to be of the desired quality? They are consigned to the medical waste bag, or subjected to cryogenic freezing, or they become the objects of experimenta-

"Meanwhile, couples who want only a beautiful and brilliant child may use sperm provided by good-looking men with high IQs. Or they may pay tens of thousands of dollars to beautiful women attending the nation's top universities to undergo an egg extraction procedure — which can lead to serious side effects, such as infection, infertility, increased risk of cancer, and, on occasion, even death.

"A couple may also pay a woman – known in the dehumanizing industry parlance as a "gestational carrier" – to carry their baby. In a few cases, surrogates have died bearing children for others. These women are commonly denied any right to participate in the life of the child they carried. Moreover, surrogacy contracts may require the surrogate mother to abort if the baby has a perceived defect or is otherwise no longer wanted, a requirement that has led to bitter litigation. Nor is there a requirement that the baby-buying parents actually accept their order. For example, a few years ago, an Australian couple paid a Thai woman to gestate two children but refused to take one home because he had Down syndrome. When it later came to light that the father was a convicted sex offender, the surrogate sued for custody of the boy's sister but lost – even though the judge ordered the father to never be left alone with his daughter."

Smith referred to a *Washington Post* story by Ariana Eunjung Cha (10/21/17) which noted that the "California IVF Fertility Center is pioneering what some refer to as the "Costco model" of babymaking, creating batches of embryos using donor eggs and sperm that can be shared among several different families." Cha goes on to note that "intelligence drives the pricing: Many companies charge more for donors with a graduate degree. Talent sells too."

Smith stated that these are "examples of "positive eugenics," using techniques of selection to ensure that a baby has desirable characteristics," as opposed to "'negative eugenics', which involved involuntary sterilization to prevent the undesirable from 'breeding." He goes on to note that new technologies such as CRISPR "could make the manufacture of 'superior' babies more precise." CRISPR research is being done using human embryos that were created specifically for the research. "The ostensible point of such experimentation is to prevent genetic disease. But many of these technologies could also be applied to make designer babies... Dr. David King, director of Human Genetics Alert, recently warned a Reuters reporter that CRISPR could "create this new form of consumer eugenics in which people choose the cosmetic characteristics and abilities for their children and enhance them to perform better than other people's children.""

In 1980, columnist Ellen Goodman wrote an article supporting IVF, stating that embryos would never be treated as discardable, "as if they were no more meaningful than a dish of caviar." She later wrote an article in favor of embryonic stem cell research. Wesley Smith emailed her "pointing out that she was supporting a policy that treats embryos as if they were no more meaningful than a dish of caviar." She responded, "My lines have changed." Smith reflected, "And thus the blithe assurances that we will know where and when to stop are just platitudes." (Wesley J. Smith, LifeNews.com, 8/2/13)

Smith noted that it is ironic that as this technology expands to create and design children, many children "yearn in vain to be adopted – even as the adoption process has become increasingly difficult."

In addition, there are currently **700,000 to 1 million** human embryos currently stored in the US. These embryos can be stored (costs can range from about \$350 to \$1000 per year), thawed and allowed to die, donated to research (where they will be destroyed/discarded), or they can be donated to a couple to be adopted. Adopting these children and allowing them to survive is an act of love and saves his/her life. (For more information see

BABY'S LIFE BEFORE BIRTH

- My heart is beating at 18-25 days.
- The foundation for my nervous system is in place at 20 days.
