FEDERAL LEGISLATION

Joe Biden was sworn in as President of the U.S. on Jan. 20, following more than 12 weeks of election disputes. Several election lawsuits are still moving through the courts.

Pres. Biden signed 45 Executive Actions in his first two weeks in office, including 27 Executive Orders. Many institute new policy, and thus are

more like laws. Others have revoked the Mexico City Policy, the Protect Life Rule, and again sent taxpayer funds to International Planned Parenthood.

"Personnel = Policy": Nominated/confirmed to positions in the new Administration are: Gov. Raimondo for Commerce Secretary (signed 'abortion thru birth' bill); Mayor Walsh for Labor Secretary (renamed a street after an abortionist); Chief of Staff Klain (NARAL 'soldier'); Dr. Kessler for Vaccine 'czar' (fast-tracked RU-486 approval); Francis Collins for NIH ('aborted baby-parts research is prolife'); Jamie Harrison to head DNC (supports abortion on demand); Dr. Rachel Levine for Assistant Health Secretary (took Mom out of personal care home after creating policy to readmit 'healthy' COVID patients); Samantha Power for USAID (radical pro-abortionist).

The pick for Attorney General is former SCOTUS nominee, now DC Court of Appeals Judge, Merrick Garland. It is speculated that activist Kentanji Brown-Jackson will replace Garland on the DC Circuit, and then Jackson will replace Justice Bryer on SCOTUS if/when he retires. Activist Kristen Clarke is the nominee for Assistant Attorney General for Civil Rights.

The House of Representatives has a slimmer than expected Democrat majority. The Senate is split 50-50, after two GOP losses in Georgia on Jan. 5. House Democrats changed a rule, limiting the "motion to recommit" procedure. It is now harder for the minority party to amend legislation.

HR.1/S.1 was reintroduced. It restricts many of the safeguards that have served our elections fairly well for the last 120 years. AMAC reports it includes federal control of elections, effectively resulting in a takeover of state elections. It also includes taxpayer funding of candidates. It would reduce the Federal Elections Commission from six to five members, effectively resulting in one-party oversight of federal elections and campaign finance laws. **HR.1/S.1** also includes First Amendment restrictions, especially by broadening public disclosure of donors to non-profit (501c4 and c6) organizations. Donors could be subject to harassment and intimidation, and thus lead to less civic engagement and free speech. Parts of **HR.1/S.1** may violate the US Constitution.

Re-introduced Pro Life Bills in the Senate or House:
S.61 - Pain Capable (20 week) abortion ban
S.123 - Born Alive Abortion Survivors Protection Act
HR.188 - Lets States deny Title XIX funds to abortionists.
HR.343 - States must report Medicaid-funded abortions.
HR.500 - To maintain Trump's Protect Life (Title X) rule.
HR.552 - Abortion pill clients must be told about reversal.
HR.554 - Abortion pills must be dispensed in person
(Note: SCOTUS has upheld the FDA's 'in person' rule).
HR.555 - No disposing fetal remains in landfills or water.
HR.620 - Abortionists must see to proper fetal disposal.
HR.626 - Woman must get exam pre & post abortion pill.

Federal Legislation continued......

HR.627 - Bans taking minors to other States to avoid parental consent laws.

Two hundred House members sent a letter to Congressional leaders, stating they will oppose any attempt to weaken the Hyde Amendment. Forty-eight Senators sent a letter to Senate Majority Leader Chuck Schumer stating that they will block any bill that would undermine the Hyde Amendment or other current protections for the unborn. (41 Senators can block any bill with the filibuster. Sixty votes are needed to end the debate.)

The U.S. Supreme Court will not hear *Bruni v City of Pittsburgh*. It included a question regarding a local 'bubble zone' law.

A Kansas Supreme Court ruled in 2019 that abortion is a state constitutional right. The Kansas Legislature recently passed the "Value Them Both" constitutional amendment overturning the ruling. The amendment will be on the ballot in Kansas in August 2022. *Personhood.org* stated the amendment will not ban abortions; it allows the legislature to decide the question.

The CA Supreme Court affirmed that California law restricts post-viability abortions by allowing a murder charge against a woman who had a stillbirth after using drugs.



NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATION

On Dec. 22, 2020, the governor signed the Jonah Bichotte Cowan Law, requiring

hospitals to treat a woman in pre-term labor or send her to where she will get care.

New Yorkers for Constitutional Freedoms lists the following action items in the NYS 2021-2022 Legislative Agenda:

* Infant Recovery Centers Act, a pilot program for recovery centers for opiate-addicted infants.

* The Live Act, criminalizing knowingly causing injury to a pregnant woman.

• A law creating an affirmative and enforceable requirement that medical care be provided to infants surviving abortion.

* A law to criminalize harm to unborn children as a result of assaults on their mothers.

• Parental notification before abortion procedure is performed on a minor.

* Opposing the Medical Aid in Dying Act, or other measures legalizing physician-assisted suicide.

* Opposing government funding for elective abortions and/ or abortion providers.

* Oppose compelled speech requirements or onerous reporting requirements on pro-life pregnancy centers.

* Oppose any measure requiring or promoting "emergency contraception" on college campuses.

*Oppose any 'Equal Rights' amendment to the state constitution that would establish a fundamental right to abortion

HEALTH & SCIENCE Angels in Waiting



Angels In Waiting (AIW) is a (501(c)(3))public charity created by nurses who are addressing the needs of America's growing fragile foster care population." Their website is: angelsinwaitingusa.org. The CEO/founder of the organization is Linda West-Conforti, RN. AIW "helps facilitate the foster child's move from hospitals, institutions, group homes and poorly supported foster homes into private residences under the care of Registered Nurses and Licensed Vocational Nurses as their foster parents. Nurse-Foster Providers supply three essential ingredients for these infants and children to heal – A Loving Enriched Home Environment – Individualized Nursing Care – Early Intervention Therapies." The organization was featured on The Doctors Show several years ago.

Across the country, there is a growing number of medically fragile infants and children in the foster care system. Many are left alone in hospitals or institutions because of their needs and are often identified as "failure to thrive". The "increase in epidemic drug use among pregnant women has resulted in an escalating number of premature foster care infants with marked medical and developmental complications... returning them to their biological home is not in the child's best interest. Each year, thousands of children enter the foster care system needing specialized medical care. They may require medical equipment such as IV infusions, feeding tube, nebulizer or oxygen. Others require a medical team that monitors and manages congenital heart defects, gastrointestinal disorder, or autoimmune disorders. AIW's mission is to recruit nurses to provide consistent care to save our most vulnerable infants and children by changing State laws, providing in-home nursing care, and eliminating long-term Foster Care placements. [The AIW] Nurse-Resource-Adopt Program offers the ideal start to a happy and healthy childhood."

AIW helped in the creation of California State Law Chapter #490 in 2014. This law requires that "Priority Consideration' be given to a placement with a foster/resource parent who is a nurse provider under the EPSDT private duty nursing programs." It addresses the need for at-home care for those children "languishing" in institutions, group homes or poorly supported resource/foster homes. AIW's Independent Nurse Provider Program has an 85% adoption rate and is always looking for dedicated nurses.

AIW is also promoting **"Sammy's Bill."** This legislation addresses children whose mothers are considering a late-term abortion by providing another option. "With the aid of our advancement in neonatal science, Sammy's Bill could provide women more options and potentially viable fetuses a fighting chance at life...Recent scientific studies show a 75% survival rate at 24 weeks gestational age...As a result of these new advancements, many 24-week gestational age fetuses chosen for abortions can be potentially viable human beings by today's medical standards. Moreover, studies show many women who experience late-term abortions suffer from emotional distress and conflict for many decades, if not for their lifetime.

The Supreme Court did not define viability because they say the point of viability varies. The court ruled in Roe v. Wade (1973) and reaffirmed in Planned Parenthood v. Casey (1992) that viability is the point at which there is a realistic possibility of maintaining and nourishing a life outside the womb, creating a "compelling interest" in protecting the life of the developing infant. Advancements in Neonatal technology such as Advanced Hemodynamic Monitoring, Continuous Positive Airway Pressure (CPAP), High Frequency Oscillatory Ventilators, and much more are dramatically improving the chance of life for premature births. Over the last two decades, we have seen tremendous improvements. Treating a 24-week gestational age preemie in the early 2000s was near 25%, where today we see a significant increase of a 75% success rate...

"Sammy's Bill would allow women intent on having a late-term abortion of 24+-weeks to terminate their pregnancy and save the life of the potentially viable fetus. This legislation would allow doctors to induce labor using the same safeguards, techniques and pre-term induction protocols already in use to successfully save 24-week gestational age 'wanted' preemies." Once these babies are cleared to be released from the Neonatal Intensive Care Units, organizations like AIW will work to give "these viable infants and children a fighting chance at life, love, and a forever home." AIW and similar organizations are "saving the ones we can by offering women more options."
