**Abortion Funding** - Government Report Shows Hundreds of Millions in Tax Dollars Going to Planned Parenthood, Other Abortion Advocates by Randall K. O'Bannon, Phd. NRL Dir. of Education & Research, *NRTL News Today*, March 27, 2015.

In a \$3.8 trillion federal budget, it isn't always easy to keep track of where all the money goes. But one thing a recent report from the U.S. Government Accountability Office (GAO) makes <u>clear</u> is that groups such as abortion giant Planned Parenthood and the chemical abortion promoter Population Council <u>continue</u> to find ways to tap into government programs to the tune of hundreds of millions of dollars a year to keep themselves afloat and active.

The tally for 2010-2012? More than \$1.5 **billion** to Planned Parenthood and more than \$120 million to the Population Council. It is government largesse like that, that helps explain how you end up with U.S. Taxpayers covering 41% of Planned Parenthood's annual budget. Reprinted with permission.

HR 36, the Pain- Capable Unborn Child Protection Act has not seen House action since being 'shelved' on Jan. 22.

S 178, the Justice for Victims of Trafficking Act of 2015, is mired in abortion politics. Pro-abortionists wish to strip out the usual Hyde Amendment bans on abortion funding for the trafficking victims. Rep. Issa [R-CA] says HHS's Office of Refugee Resettlement is now being investigated for anti-life/anti-religious bias on how recent grant awards, to aid trafficking victims, were determined. The vote on Attorney General nominee Loretta Lynch is being delayed until after S 178 is resolved.

**NOTE:** LICL objects to ObamaCare because parts in it include abortion coverage & abortifacient/ sterilization /contraception coverage at taxpayer expense, and direct or implicit limiting of care to vulnerable populations such as sick newborns and the terminally ill.

Tom Renker, Esq. (Chief Council, DRVC) said on March 25 the NY Archdiocese v Sebelius case, which includes DRVC and it's Catholic Health Services, has been reheard in light of the 2014 pro-life decision in the Hobby Lobby SCOTUS decision, and the subsequent minor changes made to the HHS Mandate on 8/22/14. A decision is expected soon.

# Federal Legislation continued...

The Hobby Lobby case turned, in large part, on 1993's Federal Religious Freedom Restoration Act (RFRA). A State RFRA law has been much in the news lately. R. T. Anderson (Heritage Foundation) says, "Religious freedom bills...protect against government coercion. They don't infringe on anyone's rights. They simply create a standard that government must meet before it violates the free exercise of religion of any citizen," CNSNews.com [4/3/15].

# **NEW YORK STATE** LEGISLATION

**Abortion Expansion Bill passes in** Assembly: On March 25 the NYS Assembly passed bill, A06221,

expanding abortion in the third trimester. There are twenty-two Assembly members representing Nassau and Suffolk. A Yes vote is in favor of expanding abortion rights. Those voting yes were: Thiele, Englebright, Ramos, Jean-Pierre, Lavine, Schimel, Hooper, Kaminsky, Solages. The No votes were: Palumbo, Murray, Graf, Garbarino, Fitzpatrick, Saladino, Lupinacci, Raia, McDonough, Montesano, McKevitt, Ra, Curran.

Funding of abortion in NYS: NYS is continuing to make taxpayers fund abortions in the state health care system. The Butler Amendment, which would have stopped this, failed to pass in the 2015 Assembly budget bill.

# HEALTH & SCIENCE "Industry of Death"

In June of 2010, Susan Michelle posted an investigative series entitled "Industry of Death" at www.bound4life.com/blog detailing the profitable fetal research industry. She cited a thesis written by Vicki Evans

in 2009 entitled, 'Commercial Markets Created by Abortion: Profiting from the Fetal Distribution Chain'. Although fetuses are reported to be disposed of as organic medical waste, that is not what always happens. Evans cited a Life Dynamics study regarding wholesaling fetuses: "The wholesaler (or middleman) enters into a financial agreement with an abortion clinic (the seller) to pay a monthly 'site-fee'...to the clinic. In exchange, the wholesaler is allowed to position a retrieval agent inside the clinic, where he is given access to the dead fetuses and a workspace to harvest their parts." Evans detailed the 'fee-for-service' schedule of these parts: liver \$150, pancreas \$100, kidney \$125...[with] gross monthly revenues of between \$18,700 and \$24,700, depending upon whether the parts were shipped fresh or frozen..." Life Dynamics noted that although the study resulted in congressional hearings, nothing was actually done: "The hearings were doomed from the start by the national political system...The biggest obstacle in trying to stop the trafficking of baby parts was the fact that Democrats were in bed with the sellers [abortion industry], and the Republicans were in bed with the buyers [pharmaceutical and biotechnology industries]."

In Part 2 of her series, Michelle notes that "Because fetal cells grow more quickly and have more applications in research than adult cells, the ethical debate on whether or not to use fetal cells is not an issue to many. It's a race to create the medicines that can be patented and sold to the highest bidder. Who wants to wait for adult tissue to grow?...Federal funding from the National Institute of Health (NIH) can be given to a professor at a public university who is researching a drug, possibly using fetal cells, and that professor can, under the Bayh-Dole Act, patent that research, found a biotech start-up company and make a fortune off aborted babies, with federal funding of his research from the NIH or his or her university. It's not only regular medications that use fetal cells, but historically, vaccines have relied on abortion to thrive." (See the Children of God for Life website, www.cogforlife.org) Evans notes that "one fetus can be the source of a cell strain with a potential yield of about 20 million metric tons (net weight) of cells, which can be stored frozen for many years...In addition, aborted fetuses and/or their organs are seemingly easy to obtain, and the cost of tissue procurement is negligible."

Susan Michelle notes that "While it's rather commonly known that fetal cells were used in designing medication to

heal burns without scarring, many don't realize that it went beyond that to purely cosmetic applications. These include [wrinkle creams]...Most shocking of all...spas where women seek cellulite removal and other enhancements." Evans stated that a Barbados clinic paid women to carry their pregnancies to a very late stage and then delivered the babies in a forced premature birth in order to harvest the organs while "they are still as fresh as possible."

Julie Klose reported at Bound4LIFE on 4/1/15 that a 'research breakthrough' was announced by the biotech company Ganogen. "The company has recently harvested kidneys from aborted babies and transplanted them into lab rats...The goal of Ganogen researchers is to transplant fetal organs into a rat, where the organ could grow to a larger size, and then be transplanted into a human patient in need of a kidney. The process is known as Xenotransplantation. The research study seeks 'to grow human organs in animals, to end the human donor shortage,' according to Ganogen founder Eugene Gu. The use of animals in human organ development raises questions for some, yet even the researchers realize the use of aborted babies' fetal organs for medical research raises much bigger questions. Eugene Gu tried to head off ethical questions during a Reddit Q & A: 'We use organs from 17-week gestation human fetuses obtained from abortion procedures...It is definitely a complicated ethical question, but one way to view it is that we do not encourage abortions in any shape or form. If we did not use these organs, they would either be thrown into the trash or, more likely, used by other researchers to answer different types of questions...[aborted babies] are used extremely frequently throughout all of science and industry...If human fetal tissues are going to be either thrown into the trash...used for basic science research...or even used to research flavor enhancers, then it is perhaps the most appropriate to use them to directly save the life of another baby or child on the transplant waiting list...In this sense, we do not believe there are any ethical issues with our quest to save patient lives." The Ganogen website has a video which calls this transplant process 'organ engineering', but the video does not reveal that for every organ grown and donated, an unborn baby must die. Pro-life advocate Jill Stanek notes, "It is easy to see where this is heading: toward the day when human beings will be grown in the lab specifically for organ and tissue harvesting. This is horrific on so many levels."

The Ganogen website asks, "Would you accept an organ from a pig, cow, baboon or a chimpanzee to save your child's life, or your own?" Klose states the real question should be, "would you accept that organ knowing that it came, originally, from a viable human being capable of life before it was harvested? The medical advances in donor transplants have saved countless lives. The untimely deaths of our loved ones have, at times, sustained life for someone else. However, are we willing to let these advances cross ethical and moral lines?"
