Persuasive Pro-Life Seminar



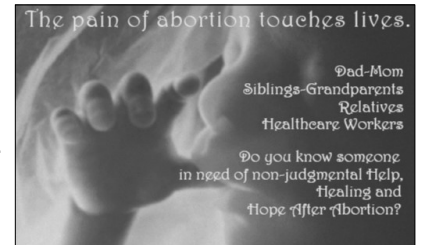

MAY: Healing the Moms & Dads

Mothers in particular, but also Fathers (depending on their role in the abortion) suffer the immediate impact of the abortion. Mother's and Father's Days allow us to focus on the abortion loss suffered by the parents of unborn children and the personal costs and effects on marriage and family life. Mother's and Father's Days can be a painful and confusing time because it touches on denial and repression of this loss...the rejection of motherhood/fatherhood of that unborn child who is missing from the family celebration.

In order to put the abortion event behind them, parents repress their feelings deep into the unconscious. Some women and many men have the capacity for a time to successfully dissociate from this painful violation of the heart, soul and body and on the surface function quite well.

Others are less able to deal with the onslaught of emotions and memories from the procedure. This is especially true of men powerless to stop an unwanted abortion and women who feel ambivalent or felt great pressure to abort. Depression and anxiety, sleep disturbance, suicidal thoughts, relationship instability, sexual dysfunction, addictions of all kinds and autoimmune disorders are ways that the abortion wound is calling attention to the lost child.

Psychological survival after participating in the death of an unborn baby requires a parent to rationalize that s/he made the right decision. However without an integrated emotional and spiritual healing of an abortion loss, denial after abortion means that even though the parent may be a decent loving individual with many wonderful qualities, they will remain deeply wounded in the deepest recesses of their heart and soul.

FEDERAL LEGISLATION

On March 24, the *American Health Care Act, HR 1628*, (the long-promised repeal & replace of ObamaCare) was withdrawn from a planned vote in the House of Representatives. It did not have the votes to pass. The (now dormant) Independent Payment Advisory Board (“death-panel”) was still in the bill. It defunded Planned Parenthood for just one year. Supporters say the bill is the start of a 3-step process of repeal & replace. Reports swirl as to whether **HR 1628** will be changed, replaced, or get a second try.

Pro-Life groups say they are urging lawmakers to craft a separate PP defund via the Reconciliation process, which will make it easier to pass in the Senate.

Update: The Senate passed **H.J.Res.43/S.J.Res.13** on March 30, with VP Pence casting the tie-breaking vote. If signed by the President, it would allow States to keep Federal Title X funds from PP. (See: LN April 2017, p 3)

Update re **HR.421/ S.93**, to streamline FDA approval of over-the-counter contraceptives intended for “routine use” by women age 18 or over. On March 13, Charles Feldman from the LI Coalition for Life phoned a staffer of the bill’s Senate sponsor, Joni Ernst, to ask “Couldn’t ‘routine use’ be stretched to allow new Morning-After pills (abortifacients) on the market?” The Staffer replied: ‘Morning-After pills are already on the market OTC.’ (Thus, it is assumed the answer is “yes”).

During his confirmation hearings, Judge Gorsuch was asked if *Roe v Wade* was “super- precedent” (a created term). *Roe*... “has been reaffirmed many times...” he said, and “worthy as treatment of precedent like any other.” When asked to reconcile *Roe* with a quote from his anti-euthanasia book, which reads “The intentional taking of human life by private persons is always wrong,” he said, “In *Roe*., SCOTUS held that a fetus is not a person...” Judge Neil Gorsuch was confirmed and sworn in as the Supreme Court Justice filling the late Justice Antonin Scalia’s seat. **Congratulations, Justice Neil Gorsuch!**

Judicial Watch, FoxNews and others report that “third-party non-victims” often benefit from Dept. of Justice or EPA suits vs Banks or Corporations. The Federal Government will say, ‘pay us a big fine, or “donate” half as much to an activist group we pick’. Often, the groups are unrelated to the offense, and may include groups ‘defunded’ by Congress. Beware of this tactic, if Planned Parenthood is defunded.

On March 28, undercover videographers David Daleiden and Sandra Merritt were charged by California with 15 felony counts, for making covert recordings of PP. Bruce Walker (*americanthinker.com* 4/1/17) urged Attorney General Sessions to investigate how often California brings such charges. A new undercover video released March 29th shows a PP abortionist describing how to deliver aborted babies intact so that their body parts can be harvested. She stated that she “pays attention to who’s in the room” if the aborted baby shows signs of life. She also stated, “I gotta worry about my staff and people’s feelings about it coming out looking like a baby.”

Tom Trinko (*americanthinker.com* 3/23/17) argues that activist judges, in striking down the President’s “travel

ban,” have unwittingly declared the HHS Mandate to be unconstitutional! The Judges ruled, ‘...anything that has a disparate impact on a religious group is unconstitutional’. Therefore, how can nuns be forced to cover abortifacients, or Catholic/Christian hospitals be forced to do abortions?

On April 3, the US State Department sent a letter to the Senate Foreign Relations Committee announcing its plan to stop funding the United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA) because of its support of forced and coerced abortions and sterilizations in China. The cut amounts to at least \$32.5 million. The State Department said it will redirect the funds to the US Agency for International Development, which provides medical care to families world-wide. By invoking the Kemp-Kasten Amendment, the President and the Secretary of State immediately stopped tax dollars from funding the UNFPA.



NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATION

The NYS Assembly passed the *Comprehensive Contraception Act A01378* (Cahill).

This bill would require insurers in New York to provide copay-free coverage for all FDA-approved contraceptives. Emergency contraception, like Plan B, which currently can cost over \$50 without a prescription, would be covered over the counter. The Assembly also passed the *Reproductive Health Act RHA, A01748* (Glick), which would prohibit parental consent and limits on government funding of abortion. It would allow late term (2nd /3rd trimester) abortions under a broad “health” exception, and would also allow non-physicians to perform abortions. In addition, this bill would repeal the requirement for a second physician to be in attendance for all abortions after 20 weeks to provide immediate medical care for any resulting live birth. RHA contains no conscience protections for pro-life hospitals or health care practitioners. Both bills are now in committee in the New York State Senate.

A2383 (Paulin), the *Legalization of Physician-Assisted Suicide* bill is currently in the Assembly Health Committee. As of this issue going to print, this bill has not been approved by the full Assembly.

HEALTH & SCIENCE

“One very good reason why Americans distrust scientists”



Michael Cook, editor of MercatorNet.com, published an article on 2/22/17 concerning the breakdown of the public's trust of the science/research community. The National Academy of Sciences and the National Academy of Medicine recently released a report entitled “Human Genome Editing: Science, Ethics, and Governance”. Cook states that “the central question it poses is whether eugenics is safe and ethical. Its answer is that eugenics would be ethical if it were safe. This is oversimplifying the tentative prose of this dense 300-page report, of course, but not greatly.”

Cook acknowledges that “there is an urgency to these questions. A technique has been found which can modify the human genome quickly and efficiently. Called CRISPR/Cas9, it allows scientists to snip strands of DNA, removing some genes and inserting others. The opportunities and the dangers are immense. If it is confined to non-reproductive cells, it can be used to develop therapies and cure diseases. Curing ailments in utero is particularly promising.

“But it will also be possible to modify the human germline cells, of the eggs and sperm or the resulting embryo so that genetic changes can be passed on to future generations. If this happens, society could be relieved from the burden of genetic diseases; parents will be able to design their offspring; and the dreams of transhumanists will start to unfold. In plain language, this is called eugenics.”

The authors of the report admit that it will be hard to stop the spread of ‘do-it-yourself’ eugenics in the United States. The authors stated, “Access to germline genome editing would be consistent with the broadest legal and cultural interpretations of parental autonomy rights in the United States...Precluding access to this technology could be regarded as limiting parental autonomy, depending upon the country and the culture. Indeed, some people feel they have a religious or historical mandate to have genetically related children.”

On February 18th, the Economist ran an article (Leaders section, “Sex and Science”) about the report and stated, “Happy parents and healthy children make a pretty good rule for thinking about any reproductive technology. A procedure's safety is the central concern. Proving this is a high hurdle. Researchers are, wrongly in the eyes of some, allowed to experiment on human embryos when they consist of just a few cells...Defining the limits of what should be allowed is more slippery. But again, the test of happy parents and healthy children is the right one. Growing sperm and eggs from body cells is surely

the least problematic new technique soon to be on offer...But the law should insist that two people be involved. If one person tried to be both father and mother to a child, the resulting eggs and sperm would, without recourse to wholesale gene editing, combine to concentrate harmful mutations in what would amount to the ultimate form of inbreeding...The first gene editing will eliminate genetic diseases in a way that now requires embryo selection – an advance many would applaud. Adults should be able to clone perfect copies of themselves, as an aspect of self-determination. But breeding babies with new traits and cloning other people raises questions of equality and whether it is ever right to use other people's tissues without their consent. The questions will be legion. Should bereaved parents be able to clone a lost child? Or a widow her departed husband? Should the wealthy be able to pay for their children to be intelligent and diligent, if nobody else can afford to do so? Commissions of experts will need to search for answers; and courts will need to apply the rules – to protect the interests of the unborn. They will be able to draw on precedents, such as identical twins, where society copes with clones perfectly well, or ‘savior siblings’, selected using IVF to provide stem cells that can cure a critically ill older brother or sister. Any regime must be adaptable, because opinions change as people get used to new techniques. Going by the past, though, the risk is not of people rushing headlong to the reproductive extremes, but of holding back, and leaving people to suffer out of a misplaced sense of what feels right.”

Cook stated that it was only a little over a year ago that the National Academy of Science held a summit and concluded it would be “irresponsible to proceed with any clinical use of germline editing [until it was safe and] there is a broad societal consensus.” Cook went on to say that even though these conditions have not been met the latest report recommended that “with stringent oversight, heritable germline editing clinical trials could one day be permitted for serious conditions. He notes that even though the report sounded cautious, its ethics are clear – “there is nothing intrinsically wrong with eugenics, provided it is safe and legal.”

The [National Academy] report suggests that the government needs to launch a public engagement program to overcome the public's resistance. Cook concluded, “this sounds suspiciously like what used to be called propaganda... [and was used successfully in the UK] to permit the creation of human-animal embryos and three-parent embryos...It is projects like this expensive exercise in justifying eugenics which widen the gap between the science community and the public. They strengthen the view that scientists regard ethics merely as an obstacle to progress. And that's not what most Americans believe.”

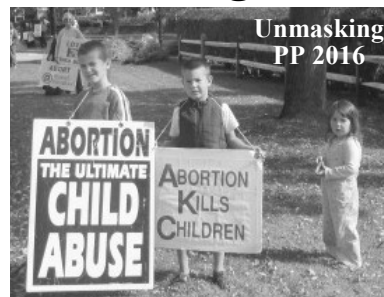
