## Heroic Students



Their excursion is over! From May 19 to Aug. 13, 12 students trekked across the United States, starting in San Francisco and landing in the nation's capital. These courageous youngsters journeyed for one reason -- to share their pro-life beliefs with others.

The walk -- "Coast to Capital: Crossroads '97 Walk for Life" -- was sponsored by Franciscan University of Steubenville students. Although their effort was conducted independently of the Catholic school, they had the blessing of university president Franciscan Father Michael Scanlan.

Andrew Doran is a junior who coordinated the third annual walk, which culminated Aug. 16 with a pro-life rally on Capitol Hill. He said the trek's success was partly due to the opportunity the trekkers had to speak with some 20,000 young people on the way.

"Our real focus is on youth because we consider ourselves to be the first survivors of abortion," explained Mary Pat Hickson, a senior. She was referring to the fact that people her age were born after abortion was legalized.

In the parish halls they visited on their journey, the marathon walkers preached their pro-life message. They also spoke on the importance of chastity, and encouraged young people to avoid promiscuity.

"Leading a chaste life and staying close to the sacraments is what Christ left us," explained Doran.

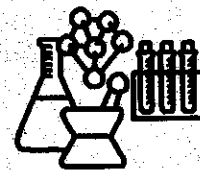

## HEALTH OF THE MOTHER -- LICENSE TO KILL

On January 22, we mourn the 25th anniversary of the Supreme Court decisions in *Roe v Wade* and *Doe v Bolton*. It would be remiss of us not to address the "health of the mother" and "meaningful life" exceptions contained in these decisions. The most-asked question we receive is "How late in a pregnancy can an abortion be legally performed?"

The *Roe v Wade* decision handed down on January 22, 1973 ruled that: A state is forbidden to "proscribe" (forbid) abortion anytime prior to birth if in the opinion of "one licensed physician" an abortion is necessary to preserve "the life or health" of the mother.

What does the word "health" mean? As defined in *Doe v Bolton*, the Supreme Court on January 22, 1973 stated that: "The medical judgment may be exercised in the light of all factors - physical, emotional, psychological, familial, and the woman's age - relevant to the well-being of the patient. All these factors may relate to health."

*Roe v Wade's* definition of health included when a pregnancy would "Force upon a woman a distressful life and future...Produce psychological harm...Will tax mental and physical health by child care...Will bring the distress associated with the unwanted child...Will bring a child into a family already unable psychologically or otherwise to care for it...Will bring the continuing difficulties and stigma of unwed motherhood."

Technically, therefore, an abortionist can kill a baby even if the mother is already in labor. The U.S. Supreme Court has specifically defined the word health to include a broad range of social and economic factors, as judged by the mother

herself. It is important to note that in statistics available from England in 1986, 132,000 of 135,000 legal abortions were due to mental health.

Although NYS law may prohibit abortions after the 24th week of pregnancy, the 1973 *Doe v Bolton* decision supersedes any NYS statutes to limit abortions.

All this concern for the health of the mother conflicts with the "care" she receives at the hand of the abortionist. The lack of sanitary conditions, emergency equipment and authorized providers often leaves women injured and even dead at the hands of the abortionist. Parental notification is denied to parents of school-aged children. Planned Parenthood, the leading abortion provider, instigated the Supreme Court's decision in 1976 that ruled unconstitutional spousal and parental consent in *Planned Parenthood v Danforth*.

The *Roe v Wade* decision justified the rights of the woman, but not the inalienable right to life of the baby because it had not reached "the capability of meaningful life - was not a person in the whole sense."

Today we are living with the results of what that "meaningful life" definition introduced - euthanasia, "death with dignity", doctor-assisted suicide, infanticide and extermination when it is determined that a person/patient is no longer capable of a socially acceptable "meaningful life".
