





LEGISLATIVE WATCH

ALMOST WON The Partial Birth Abortion procedure continues to be performed in NYS. On Wed. evening, 4/8, the NYS Assembly, by a vote of 73-71, failed to pass the Motion-to-Discharge which would have allowed a vote on the Partial-Birth Abortion ban legislation bill A.8875 sponsored by Assemblyman Patrick Manning.

Nine of the twenty-two Nassau/Suffolk Assembly Members voted against the pro-life position. These nine must be held accountable when they run for re-election this November.

HIGHLIGHTS of the NYS battle:

--The NYS Senate has in 1997 and 1998 passed legislation to ban the procedure.

--A NYS Assembly bill to ban, sponsored by Assemblyman Manning was filed early in 1998 and was stalled in the pro-abortion Assembly Health Committee. Manning called for a Motion-To-Discharge to force the bill out of committee.

groups and individuals. Letters, telegrams, ads, lobbying, and calls continued to the last minute. The highly successful petition drive sponsored by our LICL resulted in over 13,500 names delivered to Assembly Members and to Assembly Speaker Sheldon Silver on 4/7. (Please continue sending petitions to the LICL. These were a tremendous help and we thank all who worked so hard to gather

such a volume of petitions. We hope for the opportunity to present them to Congress this session).

--Legislators who did not want a vote on the bill told us it was unconstitutional. Pro-lifers argued that 22 states have voted to ban the procedure. We demanded a vote on the legislation. Speaker Silver deliberately complicated the issue by announcing his version of a bill to ban. Newsday, on 4/9, stated Silver's proposed bill "would have little practical effect". The NY Times, on 4/11, stated "recognizing that there is political momentum behind the issue, Mr. Silver has indicated he will offer up some weaker version of the ban that will be acceptable to pro-choice law makers but still allow them to tell constituents that they voted for a ban on partial-birth abortion".

--The 4/8 vote on Assemblyman Manning's Motion-to-Discharge failed 73-71. While pro-life gained over a 1996 Assemby vote of 77-62 on a similar bill, we are very disappointed that we must wait until 1999 for another chance to ban this barbaric practice in NYS.

--LICL will deliver a strong letter to each of the 150 NYS Assembly Members during our Albany trip of 4/28 to participate in the 25 Years of Tears Pro-Life Rally and Prayer Vigil. Please continue your efforts to educate as to the reality of Partial Birth Abortion. Partial Birth Abortion is occurring in NYS. Dr. William Rashbaum, A NY professor of Obstetrics and Gynecology at Cornell School of Medicine, admits that he and his colleagues perform the procedure "routinely." Source: NYS Pro-Life Reporter.

The Family Health Care Decision Act (S.4951), a dangerous piece of legislation, could come to a vote in the NYS Senate.

FETAL PAIN



"When the lives of the unborn are snuffed out, they often feel pain, pain that is long and agonizing." Pres.

Of course, the pain factor is denied by some, but most pro-abortionists remain silent. An auspicious group of professors, which included two past presidents of the American College of Obstetrics and Gynecology, and pain specialists confirmed the Reagan statement as accurate: "Over the last 18 years, real time ultrasonography, fetoscopy, study of the fetal EKG and EEG have demonstrated the remarkable responsiveness of the human fetus to pain, touch and sound...Observations of the fetal electrocardiogram and the increase in fetal movements in saline abortions indicate that the fetus experiences discomfort as it dies. Indeed, one doctor who, the New York Times wrote, "conscientiously performs" saline abortions stated, "When you inject the saline, you often see an increase in fetal movements; it's horrible." (Text and list of signatories available.)

Nociceptors (pain receptors) discharge electrical impulses to the fetus' spinal cord and brain, firing impulses outward, telling the muscles and body to react. Pain can be detected by measuring these impulses. An article in "Time" magazine, "Fertile Minds", explains that a human fetus 10-12 weeks after conception has nerve cells in its developing brain crackling with purposeful neural activity. In this time

period, the first trimester, the vast majority of abortions are performed.

If you accidentally stick a baby with a diaper pin, the baby will react and cry. The initial reflex recoil is exactly what happens in the womb, eight weeks after conception, when the fetus is painfully stimulated. A four week old human embryo already has present all three branches of the Trigeminal nerve, the sensory nerve of the face. Cutaneous sensory receptors appear in the perioral area in the seventh week of gestation. Detectable brain activity in response to pain stimuli occurs in the thalamus between nine and ten weeks gestation.

"The pain is more substantial and lasts longest when the method is salt poisoning. They are undergoing their death agony..." (Noonan) Significant pain occurs from the Saline Amnioinfusion Abortion (salt poisoning), as the corrosive burning away of the outer skin of the fetus takes place and convulsions follow

from the ingestion of the caustic fluid.

By 13 1/2 - 14 weeks gestation, the entire body surface, except for the back and the top of the head, is sensitive to pain. The Dilatation and Evacuation Abortion (D&E), wherein the fetus' tissue is punctured, ripped and crushed, is performed after 13 weeks, when the fetus definitely responds to painful stimuli.

Partial-Birth Abortions (Intact D&X) are performed from 4 1/2 months gestation on. By this time, as you have read above, the baby's body is totally sensitive to pain, and as proven, the anesthesia administered to the mother has no pain-killing effect on the baby. The Los Angeles Times summarized this procedure: "...a physician extracts a fetus feet first from the womb and through the birth canal until all but its head is exposed. Then the tips of surgical scissors are thrust into the base of the fetus' skull, a suction catheter is inserted through the opening and the brain is removed." Prof. Jean A. Wright, associate professor of Pediatrics and Anesthesia at Emory University School of Medicine, Atlanta, testified that the fetus at this stage of development "is more sensitive to pain than a full-term infant would be if subjected to the same procedures...(due to) a much higher density of Opioid (pain) receptors" than older humans.

Hysterotomy and Prostaglandin Abortions supply live fetuses for organ transplants and experimental research. We surely don't have to explain the pain connection involved in these procedures. In testimony, the reaction of a medical student attending the harvesting of a liver from a live fetus is described "...he left

the room...he just couldn't stand it".

We call these abortionists and organ scavengers doctors? They perform these inhumane practices day after day after day! Surely there should be a renewed humanitarian scrutiny of these procedures in light of present day knowledge.





Can Be Summed Up In Three Words - Abortion, Abortion, Abortion


Planned Parenthood Federation of America (PPFA) has released its 1996-1997 Annual Report. It is a report which shows an organization determined to kill as many unborn children as possible. And an organization with a money pipeline to corporations, foundations, wealthy individuals and the United States Government!

In the report, and in news stories released at about the same time as the report, PPFA brags about the number of abortions - surgical and chemical - with which it is involved.

SURGICAL ABORTIONS

PPFA is the only IPPF affiliate that openly does surgical abortions in its own facilities. PPFA's surgical abortion business has grown through the years. The

following chart will show you the trend



In 1996, PPFA did a record 153,367 surgical abortions in its own facilities. A 10% increase from the previous year! PPFA claims that 75 of its affiliates perform surgical abortion. STOP estimates that these 75 affiliates operate 130 abortion chambers. In addition to the number performed at its own centers, PPFA referred another 54,207 women to other places to kill their babies and contracted for another 261. Thus, PPFA's total surgical abortion victims were 207,835 dead children and the same number of wounded mothers plus an equal number of fathers who will never see their children.






