1996 ABORTION STATISTICS RELEASED

The most recent abortion data, for the year 1996, has been released, for both the country and for New York State. There is some discrepancy in the numbers, due to lack of reporting and under-reporting by abortion providers.

- According to the Alan Guttmacher Institute (AGI, Planned Parenthood Research), a total of 1,221,585 abortions were reported by states in 1996, a slight increase from 1995. The abortion rate (number of abortions per 1,000 women aged 15-44) was 23/1,000, up from 20/1,000 in 1995.
- The AGI also reports New York State as having recorded 168,000 abortions in 1996, second only to California, which recorded 238,000. New York's abortion rate is also second highest in the nation, with 41 recorded for every 1,000 women. This is a significant jump from last year when it was recorded at 34/1,000.
- However, the New York State Health Department records a total of 145,469 abortions in 1996, with 2,820 of them performed at or after 20 weeks of gestation, 3,994 of them performed on women having their fifth or more abortion, and 56,820 of them paid for with Medicaid dollars. (i.e. Your Tax Dollars - Ed.)
- Also, according to the state, there were 52,592 teenage (aged 15-19) pregnancies in 1996. Of these, 23,864 ended in live births, and 26,660 ended in abortions. The remainder ended in miscarriages.
- New York State Health Department also released these 1996 statistics for Suffolk County: 2583 teen pregnancies ended in 1467 induced abortions (57%); for Nassau County: 1750 teen pregnancies ended in 1092 induced abortions (62%).

PARTIAL-BIRTH ABORTIONS

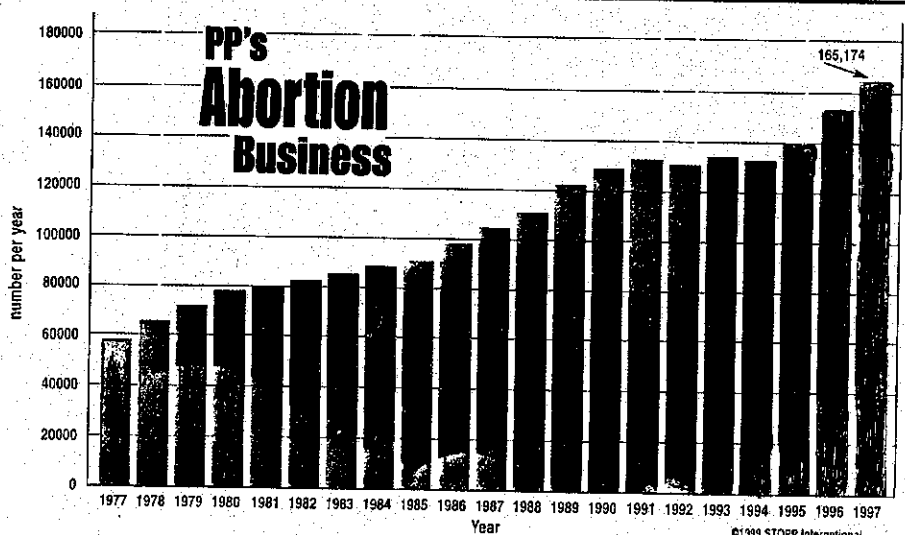
New York State does not record the numbers of abortion performed using the partial-birth abortion method (sometimes referred to as D & X, or dilation and extraction), however 822 abortions were recorded as being performed with some operative procedure "other" than the traditional methods. -*N. Y. State Pro-Life Reporter*

The high dollar service at Planned Parenthood is abortion. The chart shows the growth in surgical abortions performed at PP facilities over the last 20 years.

The first Planned Parenthood facility to perform abortions was the Planned Parenthood Center of Syracuse, New York. It began doing abortions on July 2, 1970—one day after abortion became legal in New York State.

We have not been able to locate reliable data for the number of abortions performed at PP during the early years. Therefore, the chart shows the data from 1977 to the present.

LEGISLATIVE WATCH



FEDERAL LEGISLATION

CAMPAIGN REFORM—On 8/6/98, the House of Representatives by a vote of 252 to 179 passed H.R. 2183, the Shays-Meehan Campaign Finance Reform Bill. This bill placed sweeping restrictions on citizens' free speech concerning federal politicians (Senators and Representatives). We are disappointed with the votes by Representatives Mike Forbes, 1st CD, Rick Lazio, 2nd CD, Carolyn McCarthy, 4th CD and Gary Ackerman, 5th CD, who failed to protect their constituents' First Amendment right of free speech. Shays-Meehan would also curb the rights of citizens' groups such as the National Right to Life Committee and the Long Island Coalition for Life to communicate with the public regarding the voting records and positions of those who hold or seek public office.

Fortunately Senator Mitch McConnell (R.Ky.) filibustered the Senate version of Shays-Meehan called McFain-Feingold. Because the Senate was unable to break the filibuster Campaign Finance Reform failed in the 105th Congress that ended 12/31/98.

Both the Senate and the House will take up Campaign Finance Reform in the new 106th Congress. We desperately need letters to Senators and Representatives urging them to reconsider their positions and to protect our First Amendment rights from further tampering.

NOTE: Rep. Peter King, 3rd CD voted against Campaign Finance Reform and we must thank him and ask his continued support.

NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATION



On 1/25/99 **PRO-ABORTION "CLINIC ACCESS"** legislation passed overwhelmingly in the Assembly and is currently in Committee in the Senate. Senator Joseph Bruno, Majority Leader, indicates that he is not fond of the assembly-passed clinic access bill. At this time pro-lifers must stand firm against all legislation termed "CLINIC ACCESS."

Since the Senate bills are currently in the Senate Codes Committee it is urgent that you call or write Codes Committee Chairman Dale Volker to voice your opposition.

CLINIC ACCESS is currently the most dangerous item of pro-life concern in N.Y.S. Because the Assembly has passed Clinic Access our only hope is that it will fail to pass in the Senate. The Senate is feeling pressure from Gov. Pataki who announced on 11/19/98 that he will enact Clinic Access. Pataki needs passage of Clinic Access by both Senate and Assembly to accomplish this goal. Please now write to the above mentioned Senate leaders.

THE BIOPHILES vs. THE NECROPHILES ON POPULATION

The booklet, "Life and Death Issues" by Eileen Doyle, R.N., quotes Archbishop Fulton J. Sheen. It very appropriately identifies the positions taken on the issue of population: "Our world is beginning to divide very rapidly into two classes of people: the biophilic people are those who love life. The other class of people are the necrophilics... lovers of death." Mrs. Doyle explains that the choice for death is the outcome of a "grave psychological and/or spiritual disorder arising out of excessive fear and a hopelessness bordering on despair that drives one to choose death as a solution to the problems of life." This seems to be true of those involved in population control—the "Me"ists! Their methods world-wide are abortifacient "contraceptives," sterilization, abortion, infanticide, and now euthanasia. We have all heard the expression, "Every Child a Wanted Child." Will it soon be "Every Grandparent a Wanted Grandparent," with their lives also being taken involuntarily?

The number of young people declines, largely due to abortion. The elderly live longer. The number of workers paying into the Social Security and health services pool drops. Economics thrusts euthanasia forward as the backup to abortion, just as abortion was advocated as the backup to contraceptive "failure." The vicious cycle continues on!

Many countries have already openly followed the abortion, sterilization, infanticide route to eliminate the genetically affected, mentally challenged and physically handicapped. The USA is just as guilty! Recently, we have seen a rash of legislation to advance euthanasia (doctor-assisted suicide), and health care decisions that would make ordinary humane care considered extraordinary care.

We have written previously about the one-child policy in China. A mother is forced to abort her second child, often sterilized unknowingly after the abortion or after the birth of her first child. Women in their second pregnancies are rounded up in towns to be forcibly aborted. 19,000 abortions were performed in 50 days in just one town in China! Economic pressures abound. Family stores offer 15% discounts for sterilized couples and 10% discounts for contracepting couples.

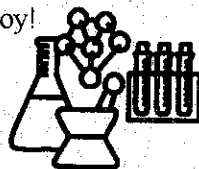
Planned Parenthood rears its ugly head in support of this China policy! Read George Grant's most revealing book about Planned Parenthood, *Grand Illusions*. Randy Alcorn's book, *Pro-Life Answers to Pro-Choice Arguments*, reveals PP's involvement in population control: "Over the years it (PP) has proposed that our government implement such things as compulsory abortion for out-of-wedlock pregnancies, federal entitlement payments to encourage abortion, compulsory sterilization for those who have already had two children, and tax penalties for existing large families." Sure sounds like PP would like a little "China Policy" here in the USA! But this is a democracy—it couldn't happen here, right? Did you ever think anyone would condone the killing of 1.6 million babies a year or that states would have doctor-assisted suicide—in the guise of "death with dignity"—on the ballot?

A few months ago we received a fundraising letter from Negative Population Growth, Inc. stating "When you think about it, the only long-term answer to human suffering on a frightful scale is a drastic reduction in numbers of people." A few of the interim steps they suggest are: "eliminate the present federal income tax exemption for dependent children, which now applies to all children regardless of number, and therefore encourages large families... give a federal income tax credit only to those parents who have no more than two children... foster universal recognition that, in an already overpopulated country and world, no couple has the 'right' to have more than two children... assure easy access... to family planning services, including voluntary sterilization... reduce legal immigration..."

The truth is, since 1972, the average birthrate in the US has been 1.8 children per average woman. This is below zero population growth. Every day more people die in America than are born. Any increase in population has been due to immigration. To maintain zero population growth requires a rate of 2.1 children per average woman. Americans are killing one of every 3 children conceived.

Let us leave you with the Reality vs. the Theory of Overpopulation: "The world, far from being overpopulated, is nearly 99% empty. Less than 1% of the land surface of the earth is used for human settlements. All the people in the world could be put into the state of Texas, forming one giant city with 1/3 of the space of this city devoted to parks and 1/3 to industry. Each family could still occupy a single-story home of 1,500 square feet—a dwelling of average US size—with a population density less than that of many existing cities, and leaving the rest of the world empty." Read *The War Against Population* by Jacqueline Kasun, Ignatius Press. Read "The World" by Marilyn vos Savant, *Reader's Digest*, February, 1992, for a similar calculation. Overpopulation—Another Abortion Ploy!

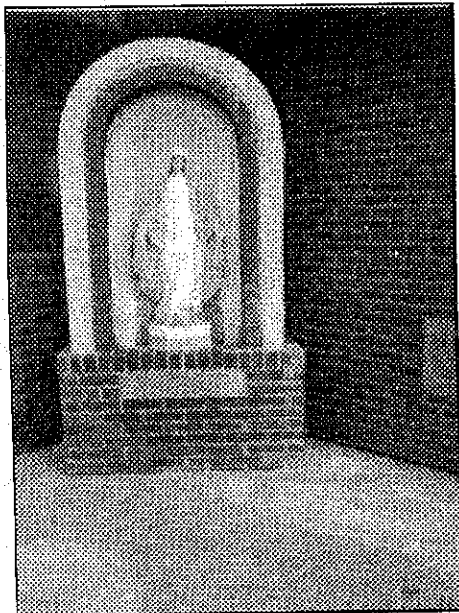
