- **What is abortion?** If you choose, learn about the different types of abortion procedures.
- **Abortion doctors speak** about their reasons for performing abortions and what it's like to have an abortion practice.
- **Abortion complications - Girls** - outlines the immediate and long-term complications specific to teen abortions.
- **Abortion complications - Guys** - discusses the immediate and long-term impact of abortion on teen fathers.
- **Abortion survivors** tell their personal stories of how they were aborted and lived to talk about it!

FEDERAL LEGISLATION

Advice and Consent to the President--

When the U.S. Supreme Court changes its role from adjudicating to legislating—i.e. *Roe v. Wade* and *Doe v. Bolton*—it presents the danger that justices from other courts are apt to fall for the same loose interpretation of the U.S. Constitution.

U.S. Senate Majority Leader Bill Frist said in the 2003/2004 Congress, "the Senate failed to perform an essential Constitutional duty. It failed to give advice and consent to the President by filibustering ten of his judicial nominees and threatening another six. These filibusters were unprecedented. Never, in the history of the Senate, has a minority (of Senators) filibustered a judicial nominee with clear majority (of Senators) support...."

TERRI SCHIAVO'S PARENTS BATTLE FOR HER LIFE

Forty-year-old Terri Schiavo's life is in serious jeopardy. Her parents, Robert and Mary Schindler, allege her husband Michael has conflicts of interest that disqualify him from being Terri's guardian. In all legal proceedings to date Michael Schiavo has failed to provide Terri with her own attorney to represent her due process rights in court. Florida law states: "Disabled persons have many personal rights that cannot be delegated to or defended by a guardian." **Note:** Since Florida Judge George Greer's 2/25 decision to allow removal of Terri's feeding tube both Florida State and Federal legislation has been introduced to protect Terri.



NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATION



HUMAN CLONING PROHIBITION ACT--

S.2400/A.4855 (also known as the **COMPLETE BAN ON ALL HUMAN CLONING**) would prohibit the use of cloning technology to initiate the development of new human beings at the embryonic stage of life for any purpose, therapeutic or reproductive. (Senator Trunzo is a sponsor of S.2400; Assembly Members Fitzpatrick and Barra introduced A. 4855 and Members Acampora, McDonough and Weisenberg are sponsors.)

Action--Sample Message to your N.Y.S. Senator and

Assembly Member: I urge you to sponsor and actively support the Human Cloning Prohibition Act S.2400/A.4855. Help those suffering from disease by supporting adult stem cell research, which has resulted in hundreds of cures and does not require the destruction of human life.

It is important that you oppose funding of embryonic stem cell research called for in Senator Spano's bill and in Senator Krueger's bill S.433 which are truly "clone and kill" bills exploiting women and diverting funds from proven life saving adult and cord stem cell research. Please reply.

Passage of the Family Protection Act would correct glaring deficiencies in our law by requiring parental notification for minors under 18 and "informed consent" before anyone could be given an abortion. (In the case of a minor the parent would be given the information given to any pregnant woman.) I urge you to sponsor and actively support passage of the Family Protection Act S.2139/A.4753. HEALTH & SCIENCE REPORT

THE HISTORY OF THE OVERPOPULATION MYTH AND EUGENICS



(Editor's note: in the first part we saw the origins of the eugenics movement.)

PART II: THE U.S. CONNECTION AND MARGARET SANGER

The International Congress of Eugenics in London in 1912 was attended by over 800 individuals including Alexander Graham Bell, Charles B. Davenport, director of the Eugenics Record Office in Cold Spring Harbor, LI, NY, Charles W. Eliot, president of Harvard, David Starr Jordan, president of Stanford, and Winston Churchill. Jalsevac states "Galton's radical version of scientific racism had effectively become a worldwide rallying call for the intellectual, cultural and scientific elite."

In 1907, Indiana became the first government in the world to "pass a bill mandating the sterilization of those considered confirmed criminals, idiots, imbeciles, and rapists in state institutions...30 states followed...by 1968, 65,000 Americans had been sterilized against their will...more than 52%...labeled as 'mentally retarded' by IQ tests which presupposed their inferiority." General Frances Amasa Walker, one of the first presidents of MIT and superintendent of the US Census was a firm believer in "Teutonism" - belief in the racial superiority of the Teutonic peoples. Walker stated "There is no reason why every foul and stagnant pool of population in Europe, in which no breath of intellectual or industrial life has stirred for ages, should be so admitted as immigrants to the US... The problems which so sternly confront us today are serious enough without being complicated and aggravated by the addition of some millions of Hungarians, Bohemians, Poles, south Italians and Russian Jews." The Immigration Restriction League was formed in 1889 and included the presidents of Harvard, Bowdoin, Stanford, Western Reserve, Georgia Tech and the Wharton School of Finance as well as many of the nation's leading bankers and publishers including Henry Holt. Chase wrote, "The overt anti-Semitic, anti-Catholic, and anti-anything-but-Aryan purposes of the League's propaganda attracted the allegiance of racists and yahoos of all stripes—from the Teutonists with Ph.D.'s to the night riders of the revived KKK." The Carnegie Institute for Experimental Evolution was established in Cold Spring Harbor, NY in 1904 under the leadership of Charles Davenport. He convinced Mrs. E. Hariman to finance a Eugenics Record Office in Cold Spring Harbor in 1910. The Carnegie foundation funded this office from 1918 to 1940 as part of the Carnegie Institution Department of Genetics. Jalsevac states that "the Record Office became the center of all eugenics activities in the US. Its most important activity was to organize the propaganda machine and begin the political activism that would

do much more to spread eugenics ideas in the US than the dismal scientific attempts in the eugenics movement...By 1914 Harvard, Columbia, Cornell, Brown, Wisconsin, Northwestern, Clark and Utah had courses in or relating to eugenics." President Calvin Coolidge refused to veto the Immigration Restriction Act in 1924 stating, "There are racial considerations too grave to be brushed aside for any sentimental reasons. Biological laws tell us that certain divergent people will not mix or blend. The Nordics propagate themselves successfully. With other races the outcome shows deterioration. Quality of mind and body suggests that observance of ethnic law is as great a necessity to a nation as immigration law."

The Nazi Connection, by Stefan Kuhl, states that American foundations were primary financial supporters of eugenics research in Germany. "The main support was the Rockefeller Foundation in NY...[it] played the central role in establishing and sponsoring major eugenic institutes in Germany" Jalsevac states "German eugenicists were so impressed with American sterilization laws that almost every piece of medical literature and propaganda written in Germany in support of sterilization referred to the American laws... American psychiatrist Foster Kennedy, who advocated the killing of mentally retarded persons, received an honorary degree from the University of Heidelberg...It was said that Hitler himself expressed admiration for Harry Laughlin's work." (Laughlin created the model sterilization law for the US.)

According to Jalsevac, "A dangerous precedent had also been established by which the wealthy of America used their vast wealth and influence to support the implementation of eugenic principles and to force them on the 'unfit'. Indeed, the eugenics movement was far from dead after WWII; it was only gathering strength for a more decisive victory. It would return in a more insidious and devastating form, and it was Margaret Sanger who would supply it with the tools it needed... The various offshoots of Malthusianism, all of which she was willing to adapt to her cause, presented the 'scientific' grounds upon which to justify her radical sexual liberation views and to argue for birth control. Eugenics, in particular, captured her imagination and changed her view of the human race... She was willing to use whatever methods were needed to bring the hopes and dreams of the eugenics movement to full fruition. Birth control or contraception, voluntary or involuntary... was her new favored method, but she also came to favor their close correlatives, abortion and sterilization." Her friends and supporters included George Bernard Shaw, H.G. Wells, Pearl Buck, Julian Huxley and Havelock Ellis. Jalsevac states that "she worked closely with almost every leading eugenicist of her time... Her close ties with these men, especially some Nazi eugenicists, indicated that she, like much of the mainstream eugenicist movement, was supportive of the German eugenics programs."

In the next part we will see Margaret Sanger's increasing influence among the rich and powerful.

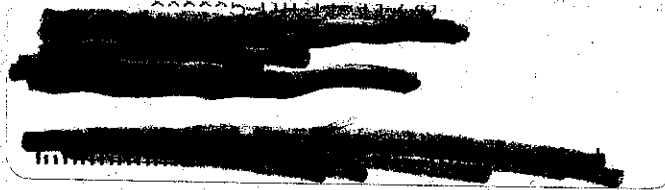

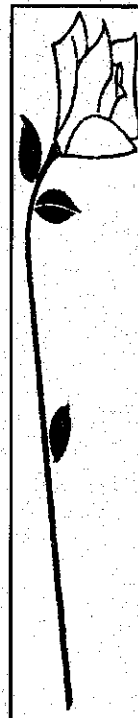
