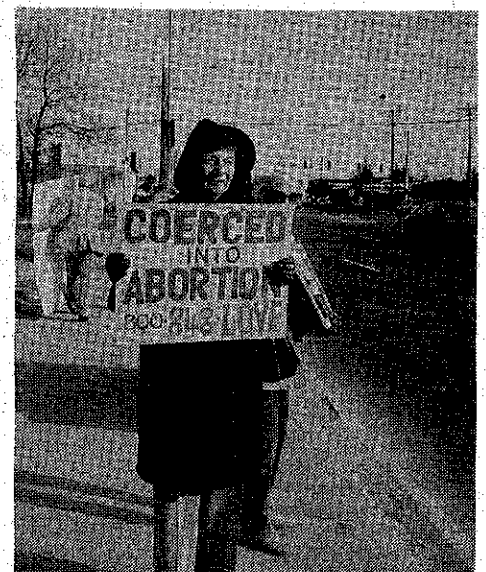
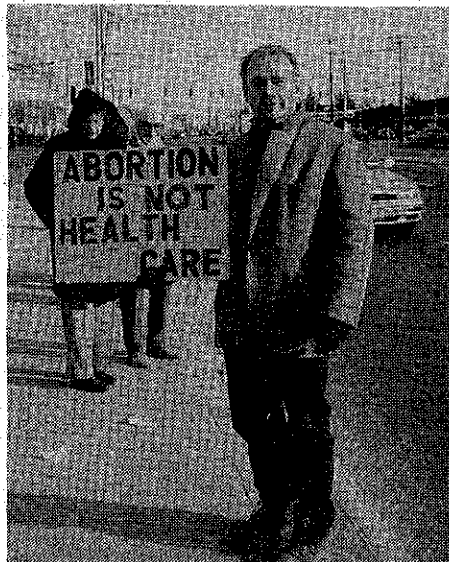

No Common Ground for Aborted Babies

As Nassau County Executive Thomas Suozzi smiles and stands with one foot in the pro-abortion camp and the other foot in the pro-life camp, the public is forgetting whom Mr. Suozzi is stepping on. And, perhaps worse, some pro-lifers are being misled into thinking that Mr. Suozzi is somehow pro-life. Mr. Suozzi's political maneuvering to look like a centrist Democrat includes offering county funding to both sides of the abortion debate for their respective programs in the name of finding common ground. But, let's be very clear - there is no common ground for the baby trapped in her mother as the abortionist's death tools attack.

This is Mr. Suozzi's view of the "center" on abortion. Referring to NYS Attorney General Eliot Spitzer - one of this state's premier abortion advocates, Suozzi was quoted by *Newsday* (2/9/06) as saying, "Eliot and I agree abortion should remain safe and legal." So, what exactly are we to discuss at the round table of common ground, once Mr. Suozzi and his friends at Planned Parenthood Inc. define the bottom line - that abortion on demand must remain legal?

The Long Island Coalition for Life has expended countless hours of volunteer time and energy and thousands of supporters' dollars trying to stop the unhealthy morally bankrupt eugenic anti-life agenda of Planned Parenthood. We are about stopping abortion. If Planned Parenthood wants to meet on our turf, a good place to start would be to stop doing abortions. Jim

Sedlak of STOPP says one way to limit Planned Parenthood's reach is to stop local funding for this pro-abortion giant. Yet here we have a county executive, who wants pro-lifers to believe he supports our mission while dumping tens of thousands of dollars into the very coffers that keep pro-lifers "in business." There are many ways to be active in the pro-life movement - giving money to Planned Parenthood isn't one of them.

And it doesn't matter that Suozzi is also giving money to pro-life causes. This is not about "balance" - this is about innocent pre-born babies being killed (with your tax dollars) under the sweet disguise of Mr. Suozzi's "Common Sense for the Common Good" program. Good for whom? The nearly 4000 babies aborted annually in Nassau County under Mr. Suozzi's administration? Where's the common sense in sexuality programs that foster disrespect for self and for one's offspring, resulting in abortion?

Does this mean we shouldn't talk to those who oppose our pro-life view? Of course not! The LICL is keenly aware that education is key to changing hearts to accept the Culture of Life and we sponsor many programs with that very intent. We know that it was love and communication that won Norma McCorvey (aka Roe of Roe v. Wade) to the pro-life viewpoint. We fervently hope that sooner, rather than later, we can report the same conversion of Mr. Suozzi. In the meantime, beware wolves wearing sheep's clothing.

STEM CELL RESEARCH FUNDING

As noted in the 2/06 Legislative column Governor Pataki announced his proposal that would leverage \$600 million in public and private funds for a biotechnology research program. As of 2/08/06 the Governor has not publicly said his plan will fund embryonic stem cell research. Perhaps the calls he is receiving opposing this research are influencing him. It is urgent that we continue to call and write the Governor and our Legislators. Action--Sample Message:

I am writing to urge you to support the exciting field of regenerative medicine using ethical sources of stem cells such as adult tissues and umbilical cord blood. I oppose legislation such as A.6300 (Silver) which would allow use of tax dollars paying for human experimentation and the destruction of human life. Please support S.2400 (Meier)/A.4855 (Fitzpatrick), the Human Cloning Prohibition Act.

Whereas embryonic stem cell research has not produced any cures for disease or disability, hundreds of cures have resulted from use of adult stem cell and umbilical blood cell research.

The best way to keep New York State a leader in the area of biotechnology is by supporting and funding ethical promising adult stem cell and umbilical stem cell research programs. SUPPORT bills that would provide funding for umbilical cord blood banking and umbilical cord blood research: S.5999-A (DeFrancisco)/A.457-A (Lentol; A.3346 (Eddington); and, A.9146 (Fitzpatrick).

THANK YOU—Please thank the four Nassau/Suffolk Assembly Members, Michael Fitzpatrick, David McDonough, Joseph Saladino and Rob Walker who voted against A.6300.A. This cleverly worded bill disguised its main purpose—allotment of hundreds of millions of tax dollars for embryonic stem cell research.

PRESIDENT JIMMY CARTER REGRETS

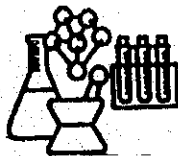
SILENT NO MORE

New York State Nurses for Life Opposes Family Health Care Decisions Bill (S.5807)



This bill provides that patients who are incompetent to make medical decisions are assigned a surrogate decision maker who then makes all the patient's medical decisions. The surrogate (18 years or older) is chosen from a "surrogate list" of all close relatives or close friends. One person is chosen from the class highest in priority (spouse, adult child, etc). Who actually chooses the surrogate? Is it the family, the hospital, the physician? How is it determined that the spouse or the adult child really does have the patient's best interest in mind? Who chooses the surrogate for indigent or homeless people who have no family? Does the state appoint a surrogate? If so, is it really in the patient's best interests? Burke Balch, J.D. reports that in Arizona, if an incompetent patient has no one to serve as a legal guardian, a county official, the Public Fiduciary, is given this authority. He states, "A physician who works with the Public Fiduciary has testified in court that, in his opinion, anyone unable to participate in 'quite a high level' in health care decision making would prefer to be dead, and therefore it is his policy to direct that 'artificial' feeding of any such nursing home resident be stopped... The 'vast majority' of nursing home deaths in Pima County result from deliberate starvation and dehydration... The Public Fiduciary can and does authorize these deaths."

There is no criminal or civil liability for decisions made by the surrogate. What about conflict of interest for a surrogate who will inherit the estate and benefit by the patient dying sooner-before all the medical bills 'eat up' the money? The hospital or attending physician refusing to comply with the surrogate's decisions to discontinue or not start treatment are not entitled to compensation for services rendered to the patient for continued treatment. Consider the problem of a surrogate with conflict of interest that wants an early death of the patient and orders the removal of the feeding tube after one month and the physician's ethical duty to his patient who he is convinced has a reasonable chance of recovery if given the extra time. The physician is powerless to help his patient. The surrogate has all the power but is incompetent to make a wise medical decision for the totally dependent patient. Tying the physician's hands seems like a sort of medical 'blackmail'.

Food and water given by feeding tube are designated "medical care". But feeding tubes or ventilators are not included under routine medical care that does not require permission to administer. They are only considered routine medical care if part of post-op care or response to acute illness and recovery is expected within one month or less. The surrogate may refuse food and water by feeding tube and/or ventilator if recovery is not expected in one month or less. According

to traditional medical ethics, food and water by feeding tube are considered ordinary medical care that is required. Ordinary care is defined as those treatments, medicines and operations which offer a reasonable hope of benefit for the patient and which can be obtained or used without excessive expense, pain or other inconvenience. For patients unable to take nourishment by mouth this type of feeding (usually by gastrostomy tube) is non-intrusive, very effective, painless and inexpensive. Without such assisted methods of feeding, all patients in need of it would die of dehydration and starvation regardless of their underlying medical condition. To deny such ordinary care to bring about the patient's death is euthanasia. It would no longer be ordinary required care if the patient is unable to assimilate the feeding due to an underlying medical condition or when the patient is in the dying process. Tube feeding may be contraindicated if fluids can precipitate pulmonary edema and cause dyspnea or if they cause nausea and vomiting, or in the case of cancer cachexia. (Dr. Joseph Anderson, oncologist and palliative care specialist, Henry Ford Hospital; Michigan Nurses for Life Publication, 2/02)

The surrogate may refuse food and water by feeding tube if treatment is an extraordinary burden to the patient, if death is expected within six months or if the patient is permanently unconscious. It is not an extraordinary burden except under the conditions cited above by Dr. Anderson in which it would no longer be ordinary, required care. But it would still be required, ordinary care regardless of predictions of death within six months or permanent unconsciousness, both of which are often unreliable and inaccurate.

An individual health care provider may refuse to honor a decision that is contrary to an individual's sincerely held religious beliefs or moral convictions, but must promptly inform the person who made the decision and the hospital, which will transfer the patient to a provider who will honor the surrogate's decision. That's saying to the physician who refuses to abide by the surrogate's demand that his patient's feeding tube must be removed, causing the patient's death, that he abandon his patient to certain death by someone else's order.

If the Family Health Care Decisions Bill becomes law in NYS, then any "Terri Schiavo", after only one month, could be killed by denial of food and water by order of a "Michael". No need to prove her wishes for death in a protracted court trial! No chance for parents and siblings willing to take care of her to plead for her life! It would all be made so convenient and easy. Her surrogate would have complete power. This law would legalize non-voluntary euthanasia by denial of ordinary necessary care to non-consenting patients.

Pro-Life Witnessing

I imagined my baby still inside.....

I was standing outside an abortion facility in late January holding a large sign with a picture of a 10-week old aborted baby. A young lady parked her car and came over to get a better look at the sign. She had no clue abortion looked like that. She said she had a "dead one" and was depressed for a long time. She gasped when I pointed out the age of the baby in the picture and that the heart beats at 8 weeks. She said she had an abortion and knew it was wrong, but didn't realize how serious it was until afterwards. For months after the abortion she would stand in front of her mirror and imagine that the baby was still inside of her. "I would pray to God to put the baby back," she said.

Those of us who stand outside of abortionists' offices hope to change the minds of the mothers headed in for abortions. Unfortunately, far more often than not we fail to do so. But our purpose goes beyond immediate "baby-saves." The young woman who spoke with me readily accepted a phone number for help with post-abortion healing. No doubt she knows other women in her shoes and will know friends with an "unwanted" pregnancy. The net effect is two-fold - babies saved and women healed... and ultimately a growing repugnance with abortion itself.

As you struggle to meet all the demands on your time and maintain your new year's resolutions, please consider squeezing in a commitment to 1/2-hour a week or one hour a month to join us at one of the abortion sites in Nassau or Suffolk.



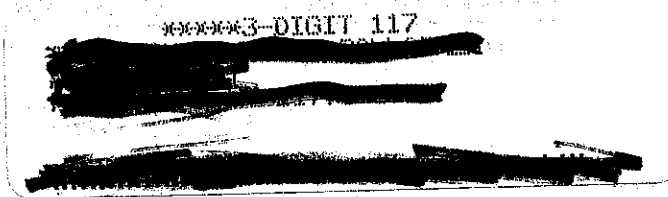
