In the New York State Legislature, we are presently fighting physician-assisted suicide (PAS) bills. Remember the slippery slope we have gone down with abortion legislation. At first we were told abortion would only be necessary for the hard cases when a mother's health and life was at serious risk. However, abortion is now legal for any reason through all nine-months of pregnancy. The same outcome will likely occur with PAS. At first the law will apply only to the terminally ill which will be defined by some arbitrary time-limit like six months, but as time goes on PAS will eventually be expanded to include the mentally ill, physically disabled and the elderly. Once you declare the purpose of PAS is to end suffering, there is no limiting principle because suffering is part of the human condition and comes in many different forms and degrees. This outcome is exactly what has happened in Belgium, the Netherlands and Canada.

Will depressed patients feel they have a real choice given the emotional and financial costs they are imposing on their families? They will feel they have a duty to die and are being selfish by choosing to live. We need your support to stop such anti-life laws.

Federal Legislation continued......



FEDERAL LEGISLATION

As of May 8, there have been 37 failed requests for a House vote on **HR.962/S.311**, the *Born-Alive Abortion Survivors Protection* Act, and two failed tries in the Senate. The Discharge Petition, to force a vote on **HR.962**, despite Speaker Pelosi's objection, needs 19 more sig-

natories to pass. Reps. King & Zeldin signed.

The House is expected to vote on the so-called *Equality Act*, **HR.5**, in May. This bill would degrade the Religious Freedom Restoration Act and the ability of citizens or organizations to claim a violation of their Right to Free Exercise of Religion. (See LN, May 2019, p.3)

The *Child Tax Credit for Pregnant Moms* Act **HR.2266**/ **S.1150** has been reintroduced and is now in committee. It would allow pregnant women to claim the Child Tax Credit for their pre-born child. Rep. Zeldin cosponsor.

Supreme Court:

In February, the Supreme Court 'stayed' a Louisiana law requiring abortionists to have admitting privileges at a hospital within 30 miles of their facility. (See LN, April 2019, p.3) Three abortionists from the State have now filed an appeal with SCOTUS, asking them to rule the Louisiana law unconstitutional. Accepted cases are announced in June. If accepted, oral arguments would be heard in the fall with a ruling in the spring of 2020. The petitioners are *Hope Medical Group* and two others.

Federal Administration

Roger Severino, head of HHS's Office of Civil Rights reported that the Conscience and Religious Freedom Division received 343 complaints of religious or moral discrimination in 2018. Complaints include: medical providers forced to train for, assist at, or perform abortions; states forcing individuals or entities to include coverage for, refer for, or pay for abortions; doctors concerned they'll be forced to prescribe suicide drugs; parents opposed to vaccines allegedly made with aborted baby parts.

As of April 29, two federal judges have put nationwide injunctions on the new *Title X* rules requiring financial and physical separation of facilities that provide 'family planning' and facilities that do abortions. PP is to get \$44 million less Title X funds than last year.

HHS announced that the Obria Group will receive \$5.1 million over the course of three years in Title X Family Planning funding to expand services to low income families in four California counties. According to the Obria website, their clinics do not provide contraceptives or perform abortions. However, some pro-lifers have questioned whether Obria will refer clients to 'partners' for these 'services.'

Other States:

- *NC: At least 5 Democrats will join GOP legislators to try to over-ride Gov. Roy Cooper's recent veto of a State "Born Alive" bill.
- *NJ: Governor Phil Murphy has signed a Doctor Assisted Suicide bill. It will take effect 8/1/19.
- *SC: Governor Henry McMaster will sign a 'Heartbeat' abortion law.

*OK: A law was passed forcing facilities that sell the abortion pill to tell clients the process can be stopped before taking the second pill. (ACLU is likely to sue). Since 2007, approximately 600 pre-born lives have been saved by the Abortion Pill Reversal technique. [lifenews.com 4/26/19] *KS: Governor Laura Kelly vetoed a bill similar to Oklahoma's. Kansas' Supreme Court rejected a law banning dismemberment abortion, saying the right of personal autonomy is "firmly embedded" in the State's Constitution and it includes the choice to keep or end a pregnancy.

*CA: On April 19, lawyers for David Daleiden's assistant, Sandra Merritt, petitioned the California Supreme Court to review the case against David & Sandra. They face 15 felony counts for covert video recording. Later that day, the Chief Justice issued a Stay to "permit consideration." This prompted the judge in the case to 'suspend all further proceedings' against the pair indefinitely.

California's Dept. of Managed HealthCare, urged on by PP, is still trying to force three churches to cover abortion in their employee medical plans. Hartford, CT passed a law forcing Caring Families CPC to tell clients they are not qualified to offer their provided services (ADF is suing). *Twenty-one State Attorneys General (including NY's) filed an *amicus* brief versus Mississippi's 'Heartbeat' abortion law (an injunction is already in place).

<u>ACTION ITEM:</u> Please urge your House members to bring up a vote on the *Child Tax Credit for Pregnant Moms Act* **HR.2266/ S.1150**.



NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATION

A 9-year-old boy, with help from his Dad, has launched *ConvertCuomo.com* to pray and fast for the Governor's reform.

Doctor-Prescribed Suicide: A02694/S03947 are currently in the Assembly and Senate Health Committees. This legislation is a lethal threat to the terminally ill, elderly, and the disabled.

Pregnancy Center Disclosure Act: Bill S.2264-Hoylman/A.2352-Glick: Not being content with passing the most liberal abortion policy in the country, our legislature now wants to impose restrictions on Crisis Pregnancy Centers, demanding that upon first contact with any potential client, they make clear that they do NOT provide abortion services, or referrals for the same. Obviously, this law would not apply to PP or similar facilities. The inherent danger of Bill S.2264-Hoylman/A.2352 is that any complaints by a "client" that they were not informed at first contact would trigger an investigation by the Health Department, with possible fines imposed. This law could be exploited by unscrupulous persons to harass and hinder the mission of CPC's.

In most countries killing another person is considered murder, even if the intention is to "ease the pain," even if the person has a terminal illness. Accepting euthanasia means accepting that some lives, such as elderly or people with disabilities, are worth less than others. Legalizing euthanasia would send a clear message: it is better to be dead than sick or disabled. What most people don't take into consideration is, the right to die implies the duty to kill! Meaning, the so called "right to die," for the patient, implies the duty to kill for someone else, in this case the doctor. Unfortunately, In the United States alone, euthanasia is legal in eight jurisdictions: California, Colorado, District of Columbia, Hawaii, Montana, Oregon, Vermont and Washington. Who are these people who have fought hard enough to pass a law that goes so much against the human spirit of hope, as well as, fighting for survival? I will tell you, they are people who are unaware of the true value, importance, and essence of life. Each and every one of us were born into this world to give glory to God, through the preservation of our souls. Those who do not possess the use of reason give glory to God merely through their existence, so why is it that these are the most commonly euthanized patients? Not viewing euthanasia from a religious standpoint is challenging for all members of the Catholic Faith, to which I belong. With that said, even if I were to take into consideration the argument that a terminally ill patient should have the choice to relieve him or herself from suffering each and every day, I would still condemn euthanasia, because in some cases a patient doesn't have to be terminally ill to qualify for euthanasia.

One of the most controversial cases was the death of 64-year-old Godelieva De Troyer, who was suffering from severe depression. Godelieva obtained psychiatric care for a number of years for her depression that she dealt with a majority of her life. Her depression was portrayed to be caused by a lost relationship with a partner and a distant relationship with her children. De Troyer was first refused her request to be euthanized by her own physician, because she refused to address the main cause of her depression, which was the distant relationship with her children. Godelieva's depression was treatable, as all depression is, however she was uncooperative and refusing treatment. Distelmans, an oncologist chosen by Godelieva, facilitated De Troyer's death under Belgium's euthanasia law after determining she had "untreatable depression." Belgium's euthanasia law states that one qualifies for euthanasia if they are experiencing "constant and unbearable physical or mental suffering that cannot be alleviated." However, depression is not a terminal illness, it can be alleviated when the patient cooperates with the terms to treat their mental state. It seems as though De Troyer had given up, which is exactly what euthanasia is. Euthanasia encourages us to give up, to abandon our hope and end our lives. Even terminally Ill patients who desire death are depressed and depression is treatable in those with terminal illness. In one study, of the 24 percent of terminally ill patients who desired death, all had clinical depression.

In conclusion, a request for assisted suicide is generally a cry for help!
