<p>ABORTION ON DEMAND: The 1973 Roe v. Wade and Doe v. Bolton Supreme Court decisions legalized abortion on demand throughout the United States. There have been more than 59 million abortions since then.</p>	<p><i>"Let me be clear -- I am pro-life... I did not always hold this position, but I had a significant personal experience that brought the precious gift of life into perspective for me."</i></p>	<p>In 2003, Hillary Clinton voted to endorse <i>Roe v. Wade</i>, which allows abortion for any reason. In 2016, Clinton said, <i>"The unborn person doesn't have constitutional rights,"</i> later adding she believed this to be true even on the unborn child's due date.</p>
<p>PARTIAL-BIRTH ABORTION: The partial-birth abortion procedure -- used from the fifth month on -- involves pulling a living baby feet-first out of the womb, except for the head, puncturing the skull and suctioning out the brain. The Partial-Birth Abortion Ban was upheld by the U.S. Supreme Court in 2007, in a 5-4 decision.</p>	<p>In 2000, in his book <i>The America We Deserve</i>, Donald Trump wrote that after consulting with doctors about the partial-birth abortion procedure, he concluded that he would support a ban on that method.</p>	<p>In 2003, Hillary Clinton voted against the Partial-Birth Abortion Ban Act (voted to allow partial-birth abortions to continue) every chance she got.</p>
<p>NOMINATIONS TO THE U.S. SUPREME COURT: The next president may have the opportunity to appoint three or four justices to the U.S. Supreme Court.</p>	<p>In May 2016, Donald Trump released a list of eleven conservative judges whom he would consider for a Supreme Court vacancy, saying, <i>"By the way, these judges are all pro-life."</i> <i>"I am looking to appoint judges very much in the mold of Justice Scalia."</i></p>	<p>Hillary Clinton has said that she would only nominate Supreme Court justices who would uphold the decision that legalized abortion on demand. <i>"I would not appoint someone who didn't think Roe v. Wade is settled law."</i></p>
MIKE PENCE (VP - REPUBLICAN)	TIM KAINE (VP - DEMOCRAT)	
<p>Mike Pence had a solid pro-life voting record on abortion during 12 years in the U.S. House, including votes for passage of the Partial-Birth Abortion Ban Act. As governor of Indiana, Mike Pence championed many pro-life measures.</p>	<p>Tim Kaine voted against the pro-life position in the U.S. Senate every chance he got. He voted against the Pain-Capable Unborn Child Protection Act. Tim Kaine co-sponsored a bill (S. 217) that would nullify virtually all state limits on abortion, including late abortions.</p>

All my systems are working. ♥ My movements by 16 weeks are quite active and I can be seen performing somersaults on ultrasound but am not yet felt by my mother. ♥ From the 3rd month on nothing new develops. I continue to grow in size and by 20 weeks I have hair on my head, weigh 1 pound and am 12 inches tall.
