Legislative

There are five statewide Proposals on the election ballot this November. These are Amendments to the NYS Constitution. Here is information on 3 of them.

Proposal 1: "Amending the Apportionment and Redistricting Process" – This amendment affects the bipartisan Redistricting Commission, which is tasked with redrawing Congressional and Legislative districts in NY following the US Census. Among several other changes, this amendment makes changes to the redistricting process in NY such that it would give an advantage to the majority party to decide the new district lines.

Proposal 3: "Eliminating Ten-Day-Advance Voter Registration Requirement" – Current NYS law requires a citizen to register to vote at least 10 days before an election, which gives time for voter verification. This Amendment authorizes the legislature to enact laws permitting a citizen to register to vote less than ten days before the election, including same-day voter registration (which can make it easy for a person to vote multiple times). A newly registered voter would cast their ballot via the same method as already registered voters, instead of a 'provisional ballot' that is subject to verification.

Proposal 4: "Authorizing No-Excuse Absentee Ballot Voting" – This Amendment would delete the current requirement that an absentee voter must be unable to appear at the polls by reason of absence from the county, illness, or physical disability. That is, all voters can request an absentee ballot, opening the door to the recognized increased risk of voter fraud. (Mail-in voting and absentee voting are not the same. Mail-in voting is not as regulated as absentee voting. This amendment would make absentee voting more like mail-in voting.)

These Amendments can impact voting demographics, voting integrity and balance of power of the major parties in the legislature, and thus can affect the ability to pass pro-life legislation or stop anti-life / anti-family bills. Pro-lifers should educate themselves on these amendments (and all 5 proposals) and what passage will mean for preborn babies, those at risk for assisted suicide, etc.; and then cast their ballot accordingly.

Update regarding the Susan B Anthony "Humanity of the Unborn" ad campaign: Fox, Newsmax, Bravo, ABC, and other networks agreed to air the ad. However, CBS, CMT and the Hallmark channel, all owned by the parent group Crown Media, rejected the ad and refused to air it.

UNICEF

Fall is the traditional fund-raising season for UNICEF. As we have reported in previous years, UNICEF intervened with Nicaragua's national assembly to keep abortion legal, and it worked to liberalize abortion in the Dominican Republic, Peru, the Philippines and other countries. UNICEF Canada pushed for assisted suicide and euthanasia for children. In addition, UNICEF partners with the world's largest abortion providers and advocates to hold conferences which promote abortion. UNICEF's draft strategic plan currently under consideration includes the promotion of "sexual and reproductive health and rights," – a term widely recognized to include abortion.

Living Vital Organ Donation – Organ Donor Euthanasia

Wesley J. Smith reported at NationalReview.com (8/21/21) on “Living Vital Organ Donation,” also known as Organ Donor Euthanasia. He wrote, “We have entered the era of what I call “do harm medicine,” in which the concept of what constitutes harming the patient has become entirely malleable and subjective.” He reflected that when organ transplants began, the “dead donor rule” (DDR) was “instituted to assure a wary public that people’s vital organs would only be procured after the person was dead. A corollary to that rule assures the public that people will not be killed for their body parts.” Smith noted that the “dead donor rule” has been “under attack for some time within the utilitarian bioethics movement... Many bioethicists are now pushing to allow doctors to kill via organ harvest, sometimes called “organ donation euthanasia” (ODE).”

ODE was originally intended for patients close to death or permanently unconscious. The journal *Bioethics* recently published a paper by Didde B. Anderson entitled “May I give my heart away? On the permissibility of living vital organ donation (8/18/21). The author promotes the ability of healthy people to die when vital organs are “donated”. The justification used is that if patients can have life-sustaining treatment (LST) withdrawn to donate organs after death, then organ donor euthanasia is acceptable because it results in death as well. In addition, healthier, more usable organs will be retrieved. The author stated, “patient autonomy allows patients to refuse any medical intervention initiated on one’s body and life, and therefore, doctors are morally obligated to withdraw LST when this is what the patient wants. If we should uphold the DDR in such situations, the doctor should wait until the patient is declared dead to procure the patient’s organs. Proponents of ODE argue that if the patient consents, it would be permissible to procure the patient’s organs before death. This of course means the patient will die from donating his or her vital organs instead of dying from having his or her treatment withdrawn. However, this seems ethically immaterial in this situation since the outcome for the patient will be the same.”

Smith argued that not everyone dies from withdrawal of LST, and “under current organ-donation protocols, if the patient doesn’t die, he is taken back to the ward and usually disqualified as an organ donor thereafter. Once death ceases to be the necessary predicate for donating vital organs – and is replaced with “consent” – there would be no natural limiting principle... consent has the power to justify abundant “do harm” medical practices... once a fundamental moral principle is breached, it is like a dam breaking. The deluge may begin as a trickle, but soon the reservoir empties flooding the plains below.”

Smith noted the following progression: “assisted suicide/euthanasia for the terminally ill who ask to die was legalized as a means to prevent suffering at the

end of life. That morphed in some places into allowing people with disabilities and chronic conditions who ask to die to be killed to eliminate suffering. Which morphed into allowing the mentally ill who ask to die to be killed in some jurisdictions to eliminate suffering. Which morphed into conjoining organ harvesting with euthanasia if the person to be killed consents. Which morphed into several proposals to permit killing by organ harvesting for those facing imminent death. Which has now morphed in a proposal to allow healthy people to ask to be killed for altruistic reasons. Which will one day morph into proposals for surrogates to authorize euthanasia via organ harvesting for the incapacitated or letting people order themselves harvested once they become incapacitated in advance medical directives.”

He warns that these are not “fringe ideas... The idea of killing for organs is considered respectable in the field. And it gives these advocates no pause that their plans would also transform organ-transplant doctors – known for focusing exclusively on saving lives – into outright killers. The only way I can think of to thwart this drip-drip-drip-into-deluge process is to cast a bright light on where the thought leaders in bioethics want to take health-care policy in coming years. Forewarned, I hope, is forearmed. Hopefully, the people upon whom these policies would be imposed will disagree and thwart the best-laid plans of utilitarians and bioethicists.”

Forced Live Organ Harvesting

Doctors Against Forced Organ Harvesting (DAFOH) state, “The systematic killing of people to harvest their organs on an industrial scope is a crime that is unprecedented and should not have a place in the 21st century.” The organization is linked to the religious group Falun Gong, which is persecuted in China. They claim that Uyghurs, Tibetans, Muslims, and Christians are also being targeted by the Chinese. Dr. Torsten Trey, executive director of DAFOH said, “Forced organ harvesting from living people is an unfathomable, unspeakable disgrace to humankind. Never before in history has an authoritarian regime persecuted living people by killing them with the goal to eradicate them through the installation of a self-propelling, profit-driven organ harvesting infrastructure, potentially turning organ recipients into accomplices as their demand for a transplant surgery might have fueled the transplant abuse. This should be of concern to all humankind.”

Time-Delayed Suicide Implant for Dementia Patients

Wesley J. Smith reported at NationalReview.com (7/16/21) that 2 bioethicists suggested in an article in the Hastings Center Report that a time-release suicide device they called an “advance directive implant (ADI)” be used in order to “reduce the distress that living and dying with dementia imposes on others.” Smith commented, “In other words, we should let the patient put him-or-herself out of *our* misery.” The authors of the article state the device is a way of “getting the better of Alzheimer’s.” Smith argued, “No, it is *softening the ground for authorizing direct killing of such patients.*” Smith continued, “Articles like this... are insidious because they normalize the noxious idea that dementia patients’ lives are not worth protecting or living... Part of the essence of true humanity is caring and loving each other – no matter how taxing and emotionally devastating – especially when a person is so ill or injured they can’t take care of themselves. That’s the best part of who we should be. The movement to eliminate suffering by eliminating the *sufferer* is becoming a cult.”

Red Rose Rescue


On April 24, 2021, the national movement known as Red Rose Rescue came to Long Island and shut a Manhasset abortuary for the day – sparing the deaths of nearly ten babies at this facility during that time. Recognizing that women and children were in peril inside All Women’s Care at 444 Community Drive on this day, 4 rescuers entered and engaged all they met there, offering love, care and help to mothers, babies and staff. Among the four were one Long Islander and one Catholic priest. Upon arrival of the police, the four remained and gave witness to the primacy of human life over property. The rescuers were cheered on by more than 50 pro-life supporters, including some students of Franciscan University, travelling from Ohio. The rescuers were held until the end of the day and given desk appearance tickets for Nassau District Court; arraignment date was pending at time of this publication.
