Street fair impact across 13 years

As I was speaking to a few teens at the Long Island Coalition for Life booth at Rocky Point Community Day, a woman ducked her head under the canopy. I have a set of models 7, 8, 9 & 10 weeks human in the womb. The woman pointed to the models and said that when she was 19 years old, she saw those models at a fair. When she was 22 and in college, she got pregnant. She remembered those models and decided against an abortion. Turns out it was a fair I did once at a Cedar Beach music festival. The woman explained that she had been dating the guy for only a few months when she got pregnant. Despite pressures from family & friends to abort the baby, she still had the image of the little baby models in her mind, and she and her boyfriend – now her husband – went through with the pregnancy. She proudly pulled out her phone and showed me a video of her now 13-year-old son beautifully playing the piano.

FEDERAL LEGISLATION

There are no major life issues rulings expected at the end of the current Supreme Court term. However, on May 1, the 5th Circuit Court blocked sending the

mifepristone abortion pill by mail, requiring it to be dispensed in person. The Supreme Court put a temporary stay on that ruling on May 4, lasting until May 11. After hearings on May 7th, the stay was extended to May 14. On May 14, SCOTUS ruled the stay will continue, while the case (*Louisiana v FDA*) goes back to the 5th Circuit, as the FDA's review of the abortion pill proceeds. Justices Alito & Thomas dissented. Many pro-lifers felt FDA head Dr. Marty Makary was 'slow walking' the abortion pill review. Dr. Makary resigned May 12. Kyle Diamantas was made interim FDA head. His name was listed as one of the lawyers for a Planned Parenthood affiliate in a 2017 Florida case. March for Life Pres. Jennie B. Lichter says Kyle phoned her within hours of his appointment, saying life issues and mifepristone regulation would be early priorities of his. He said that in 2017 he asked to be removed from the PP case. On June 5, *lifeneews.com* reported "The FDA will finally launch a proper investigation" of mifepristone. Results are due in about 6 months (after the election).

On May 26, fifty Congressional members submitted an Amicus brief to the 5th Circuit Court, in *USCCB v EEOC*, urging the EEOC to end Biden era changes to the Pregnant Workers Fairness Act, forcing employers to accommodate abortion.

On June 4, Heritage Foundation released a proposed 'Reconciliation 3.0' budget plan that includes ending federal abortion funding. Reconciliation bills only need 51 votes to pass in the Senate. House Speaker Mike Johnson says he's ready to act on the plan, perhaps in time to prevent federal funds going to Planned Parenthood when the Big Beautiful Bill ends on July 4.

HR.8784/S.4507, Bereaved Parents Rights Act. Hospital/Birth Center must give parent(s) who suffer miscarriage or stillbirth full, timely information regarding options for public/private burial, cremation, etc. for their child. (No LI cosponsors)

A 3-bill "**H.E.R. Agenda**" was introduced by Arizona Rep. Y. Ansari. It contains numerous 'reproductive' issues including "pregnancy terminations," menstrual pain, miscarriages, menopause symptoms, endometriosis, IUD insertions, vasectomies, fertility treatments and biopsies.

HR.8158 - Reproductive Healthcare Leave Act. 12 days paid leave for conditions and 'care' listed above. **HR.8159 - Gynecological Pain Management Study Act.** HHS must identify 'barriers' to pain management options during/after gynecologic procedures. **HR.8160 - Premenstrual Dysphoric Disorder (PMDD) Awareness and Research Act.** NIH must do research, fund potential PMDD treatment trials, and publish PMDD info. All 3 bills have 28 Dem cosponsors (none from LI) and no Senate companion bills.



NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATION

Gov. Hochul signed the Medical Aid in Dying Act (Assisted Suicide) on Feb. 6, 2026. The mandated 6-month preparation and

regulation-building period for healthcare providers will be over, and assisted suicide becomes legal in NYS on Aug. 5. We need only to look to Canada to see where this will lead. By September, almost 1/3 of all Americans will live in states with legal "aid in dying".

The **NYS budget** passed (57 days late) on May 28. Gov. Hochul's proposed budget included a 25 ft 'no speech or protest' buffer zone around houses of worship and 'reproductive health clinics.' Organizations including the ACLU and Planned Parenthood opposed such zones, citing concerns that it would not pass judicial scrutiny and 'chills' constitutionally protected speech. The approved budget allows police to establish 50 ft security perimeters outside houses of worship only. According to NYS Right to Life, Gov. Hochul's proposed budget also included a provision "to enshrine a repudiation of parental rights in the case of minors getting abortion into law." NYSRTL reported the provision was not in the approved budget.

A10428/S08656, which would permit mifepristone or misoprostol to be dispensed without the name or address of the patient or the dispensing doctor/pharmacy directly on the prescription label, did not pass.

A3694, to require pre-abortion ultrasounds, did not pass.

A2425/S5737, allowing adoptive parents to give birth mothers more aid: The Assembly and Senate bill search pages state the bill was delivered to the Governor on 6/5/26.

A5319-C/S4468-C, Paid Leave After Stillbirth, is listed as still in committee.

A8382/S9316, Replace terms Father, Mother and Filiation to Gender Neutral Language: Steven Ertelt reported at *lifeneews.com* (6/4/26) that the NYS Legislature passed this bill "stripping the word 'mother' from state law and replacing it with the term 'gestating parent'; 'father' to 'non-gestating parent'; 'paternity' cases to 'parentage' proceedings," and 'putative father' to 'alleged parent'. These changes will affect all NYS child custody, family court, domestic relations and education laws. The bill was sent to Gov. Hochul's desk. The *NY Post* (6/3/26), reported Sen. Patricia Canzoneri-Fitzpatrick stated, "...replacing mothers and fathers in state law...is not what families are asking for. I am a mother and proud to be called 'mother.' New Yorkers...would rather we, as lawmakers, focus on the issues that actually matter." The *Post* also reported that Gov. Hochul, who proudly says she is New York's first mom governor, "dodged on saying whether she supported the gender-neutral rewrite." She told reporters she was "not familiar with what was introduced. I'll take a look at it. This has been my practice for five years."

S10637/A11553 Constitutional Amendment to Reform New York's Redistricting Process, passed the Assembly and NYS Senate. *Spectrumlocalnews.com* reported (6/1/26), "It would allow for mid-decade redistricting in 2028, and more generally outside of the normal census-driven process when necessary. Additionally, if approved by voters, it would make clear that the legislature has the authority to draw maps if the independent Redistricting Commission fails to produce one, as well as remove language prohibiting the consideration of incumbency and political party eliminating anti-gerrymandering provisions." The bill must be passed again in the next legislative session (2027) and then be put on the ballot in the General Election in 2027 and passed by voters before it could go into effect for the 2028 election. **TAKE ACTION** – For contact info on legislators at all levels go to: prolifeli.org/index.php/legislative **OR** usa.gov/elected-officials

- Rh Factor
- Base Editing Human Embryo Genes

Rh Factor

Every blood type has a positive or negative factor known as Rh. The Rh factor is a type of protein (antigen) found in red blood cells. 85% of people have the Rh factor present in their blood and are called Rh positive. If the protein is not present, they are Rh negative. Blood types are inherited, so it is important to know both parents' blood types early in a pregnancy. If a mother is Rh negative and the preborn child is Rh positive, a mother can develop antibodies to the child. If a small amount of the baby's blood mixes with the mother's blood, which can happen during delivery, miscarriage, an ectopic pregnancy or an abortion, the mother's body reacts – resembling being 'allergic' to the preborn child. If the mother's body makes antibodies to the child's blood, a mother becomes 'sensitized.' These antibodies can cross the placenta and attack the child's blood.

Mothers usually experience the results of this with a subsequent pregnancy. If the next child is also Rh positive, the mother's antibodies will attack the child's red blood cells and can cause life-threatening anemia during pregnancy. RhoGAM, Rh immune globulin, are injections that stop the mother's body from manufacturing Rh antibodies. The injections are only effective if the mother has not yet made Rh antibodies. A woman with Rh negative blood who is carrying an Rh negative child has nothing to worry about. A woman who has Rh positive blood has nothing to worry about at all. The danger exists when Rh negative mothers are carrying Rh positive children. (Source: alcovehealth.org)

Planned Parenthood claims that a woman is very unlikely to develop Rh antibodies if an abortion is done at less than 8 weeks. Now that abortion pills are widely available through telehealth or online purchases, women and their children could be affected. A recent Charlotte Lozier Institute study found that 81% of online abortion pill vendors (64 vendors) ship abortion pills to women beyond the 10-week gestational limit. 18 websites require no identification before purchase.

Base Editing Human Embryo Genes

On June 4, *The New York Times* carried an article by Carl Zimmer reporting that scientists at Columbia University "were able to meticulously replace individual genetic letters in sequences of DNA without causing the damage often observed with an earlier form of gene editing, CRISPR." Dieter Egli, the geneticist who led the research stated, "As a scientist, you can provide the data for discussion, but then essentially there you stop and let others take over." Egli said there are still questions regarding harmful side effects – "We're not saying this is going to be used tomorrow in the clinics." In 2020, Egli and his team took donated sperm from men with a gene mutation that caused hereditary blindness. Healthy eggs were fertilized with the sperm to create human embryos. CRISPR was used to "cut out the mutant region...but the repair failed in about half of them. Some chopped off long stretches of DNA. Some destroyed the entire chromosome" where the mutant gene was located. Egli said, "It had absolutely catastrophic consequences." The *Times* stated, "Many scientists and bioethicists saw these results as further evidence that editing human embryos was far too risky to even consider, at least for the time being."

In 2016, David Liu, a Harvard geneticist, "combined one of the CRISPR molecules with other compounds to create base editing, a new method for editing genes. Rather than chop out a segment of DNA, base editors made a tiny nick in one strand. They could then guide the cell to fix the mutation. Base editing has proved to be often superior to earlier CRISPR methods." Base editing was used last year to treat a baby with a potentially lethal condition. Egli and his team targeted 2 genes, one that can carry mutations raising LDL in the blood, and one that concerns fetal hemoglobin production. The team "delivered their base editors into fertilized eggs and into two-cell embryos donated by parents. The researchers didn't find any of the extensive damage associated with CRISPR. Instead, the researchers were able to successfully change both genes...In some experiments, they simultaneously changed both genes in the same embryo." However, the target DNA was sometimes missed, and the embryos were genetically mixed, called 'mosaics.' If these embryos had been born, it would have led to medical problems.

Bioethicist Ana Iltis warned that more than looking for damaged chromosomes is required. She stated, "It is possible that some of the potentially harmful effects would not be evident until after birth." The *Times* noted that Nathan Treff, a co-author of the study and chief clinical officer at Nucleus Genomics said, "the ability to fix disease-causing mutations in embryos could be a boon to those using I.V.F., allowing them to implant embryos that they otherwise would have discarded." The team is aiming to test base editing on embryos of 100 cells, which is the stage at which fertility clinics freeze and test embryos. Nucleus Genomics is supporting Egli's next stage of research. Nucleus Genomics posted controversial ads in NYC subways promoting "have your best baby." Some critics have accused the company of "putting a biotech spin on eugenics."

Keep in mind that this research involves creating, experimenting on, and then destroying human life.

Sometimes when discussing a pro-life issue, what NOT to say may be as important as what to say. For example, replying to a question about rape or embryonic stem cell research, it's better not to start by reeling off statistics. Aborting a child conceived in rape is wrong whether rape accounts for 2% or 20% of all abortions. Embryonic stem cell research (killing the embryo-child to harvest his/her cells) is immoral whether there are zero treatments or 5 life-saving treatments available using that embryo-child's cells.
