Denial of Treatment Seminar - 2/7/15

Burke Balch J.D. of NRTL and Lori Kehoe of NYSRTL spoke at the seminar attended by over 80 concerned pro-life advocates. LICL thanks all who helped in making this event a success. Attendees were cautioned to monitor the media and all pro-life



sources for possible action in the New York State legislature intended to dilute current N.Y.S laws regarding "Denial of Treatment" and to contact our N.Y.S. representatives immediately in opposition. In this

situation, Letters-to-the-Editor are extremely important to present the pro-life side of this issue.

84% of Americans support banning abortion after 3 months. Highlights of the Marist Poll sponsored by the Knights of Columbus conducted Jan. 7 – Jan. 13, 2015 include:

- * Eighty-four percent of Americans want significant restrictions on abortion, and would limit it to, at most, the first three months of pregnancy. This includes almost 7 in 10 (69 percent) who identify themselves as "pro-choice."
- * 64 percent say the nation's abortion rate is higher than it should be. Only 7 percent thinks it is too low.
- * 78 percent support parental notification before a minor can obtain an abortion.
- * 68 percent oppose taxpayer funding of abortion, while only 28 percent support it.
- * By nearly three to one, Americans see abortion as doing a woman more harm than good in the long run (59 percent to 22 percent).
- * By 20 points (57 percent to 37 percent), Americans support proposed legislation that would permit medical professionals and organizations to refuse to provide abortions or refer patients for abortions.
- * In light of the ongoing controversy over the HHS contraception, sterilization, and abortifacient mandate, it is notable that 70 percent of Americans also support religious liberty rights when religious values conflict with the law.

FEDERAL LEGISLATION

As of 2/9/15, **pro-life bills*** reintroduced for 2015:

HR 7- No Taxpayer Funding for Abortion and Abortion Insurance Full Disclosure Act of 2015. Solidifies current Federal abortion funding restrictions, and extends them to ObamaCare. Makes it easier to know if an

ObamaCare approved, private Medical Plan, pays for abortions.

HR 36- Pain-Capable Unborn Child Protection Act. To ban most abortions after 20 weeks gestation.

HR 217/S 51- Title X Abortion Provider Prohibition Act. No Title X family planning funds to abortion providers.

HR 803/S 404- Child Interstate Abortion Notification Act

HR 281- Every Child a Blessing Act. To eliminate many “wrongful birth” and “wrongful death” lawsuits.

S 50- Right of Refusal within the Public Health Service Act. Gov’t worker conscience protection, re: abortion.

S 48- Prenatal Nondiscrimination Act (PRENDA) of 2013. Prohibits sex or gender selection abortions.

S 78- Pregnant Women Health and Safety Act.

***NOTE: HR 7, HR 36, and HR 217/S 51 have Rape, Incest and Life of the Mother exceptions and are not considered by some to be truly “pro-life”.**

Pro-Abortion Bills:

HR 448/S 217 Women’s Health Protection Act of 2015.

NOTE: LICL objects to ObamaCare because parts in it include abortion coverage & abortifacient/sterilization/contraception coverage at taxpayer expense, and direct or implicit limiting of care to vulnerable populations such as sick newborns and terminally ill.”

For example: The law is written so as to obscure which Plans cover elective abortion. Some **info on coverage, and a lot more, can be found at obamacareabortion.com.**

ASK YOUR HEALTH CARE PROVIDER FOR A COPY OF YOUR PLAN TO READ, BEFORE YOU SIGN IT. (See **HR 7**, above.)

ObamaCare 2015: More planned cuts to Medicare home health care. Also, HHS said on 1/26 they want Medicare doctors paid by how many patients they see, AND *if those patients get healthier*. The Supreme Court’s *King v. Burwell* decision (in June) could mean big ObamaCare subsidy shortfalls for buyers on the Federal Exchange.

Archdiocese of NY v Sebelius: A panel of judges from the 2nd Circuit Court of Appeals heard arguments 1/22, regarding Aug. 2014 changes to the HHS abortifacient/sterilization/contraception Mandate. There’s currently a “stay.” Expect a ruling soon. DRVC is part of the case.

US Attorney General Nominee Loretta Lynch says Yes, she signed onto a PP amicus brief in support of Partial Birth Abortion. [lifeneews.com, Jan 28, 2015]



NEW YORK STATE LEGISLATION

Our old nemesis, Assembly Speaker Sheldon Silver, has resigned following a federal indictment on corruption charges. The new Assembly Speaker Carl Heastie (pronounced Hay-stee) (D)-Bronx was confirmed on 2/7. Unfortunately, Assemblyman Heastie voted for the Women’s Equality Act on 1/27/ 2014 still, we pray he will be a little more open minded to our side.

Jan. 2015 the New York State Senate passed, 62-0, eight bills under the umbrella of the Women’s Equality Agenda (WEA). The abortion provisions were cut out. It remains to be seen, as of this writing 2/10, what will happen in the Assembly under a new speaker.

A.2129 - In relation to legalizing physician-assisted suicide – introduced by Assemblyman Rosenthal.

Action: Sample message.

Physician-assisted suicide must not become legal in New York State. A-2129 would add a section to the Public Health Law to allow physicians to prescribe lethal doses of medication for the express purpose of ending a patient’s life. I urge you to work to stop this bill. Please reply as to action you will take. Thank you.

HEALTH & SCIENCE

Methods of Abortion

SURGICAL ABORTIONS involve an invasive procedure:

Vacuum Aspiration is done in the first trimester. A hollow plastic suction tube is inserted into the dilated cervix. The uterus is emptied by either a manual syringe or high-powered suction machine. The broken pieces of the child are pulled through the hose.

Dilation and Suction Curettage (D & C) is similar to the vacuum aspiration, but generally used after 14 weeks. After the child is suctioned out of the uterus, the abortionist inserts a curette and cuts the placenta and umbilical cord into pieces and scrapes them out into a basin. The uterus is suctioned out to be sure no body parts have been left behind. Bleeding is usually profuse.

Dilation and Extraction (D & E): The cervix must be dilated considerably farther than in 1st trimester abortions. Forceps are used, since the baby's bones are calcified. The abortionist uses the forceps to grab the baby's leg or other body part and with a twisting motion tears it from the body. The spine is snapped and the skull crushed. The body parts must be reassembled and counted to assure that the entire baby has been removed and nothing remains in the womb.

Induction or Prostaglandin Abortion: Labor is induced using prostaglandin drugs, and the cervix is dilated. To ensure that the baby is dead upon delivery and to start uterine contractions, saline or urea is injected. To guarantee against a live birth, Digoxin or potassium chloride may be injected directly into the baby's heart to kill the child before delivery. Other times the child may be delivered alive and left without medical intervention until the child dies. This method is used in the 2nd or 3rd trimester.

Dilation and Extraction (D & X or partial-birth abortion): The mother undergoes 2 days of dilation. The abortionist performs an ultrasound to locate the child's legs and feet. Forceps are used to pull the legs into a feet-down position. The abortionist uses his hands to deliver the child in a manner similar to a breech birth. The head remains inside the birth canal. Surgical scissors are used to pierce the child's head at the base of the skull and forced open to enlarge the skull opening. A suction catheter is then used to remove the brain tissue. This machine is 29 times more powerful than a household vacuum.

CHEMICAL/MEDICAL ABORTIONS involve the administration of drugs specifically intended to abort the child or drugs which, at least part of the time, may prevent implantation.

Emergency Contraception (EC) - Plan B: EC contains synthetic (not naturally occurring) progesterone and is a large dose of the common birth control pill. It is designed to be taken within 72 hours after 'unprotected sex'.

EC works in 3 ways. It attempts to stop ovulation, stop fertilization by impeding the transportation of sperm to the egg, or stop implantation by altering (thinning) the lining of the endometrium so that the embryo cannot implant and receive nourishment from the mother. The first 2 methods are contraceptive, but if they fail, the third method causes an abortion, since it occurs after fertilization.

Ulipristal Acetate (UPA) - ella is a selective progesterone receptor modulator (SPRM). SPRMs block the action of the hormone progesterone, which is necessary for ovulation and implantation and maintaining the lining of the uterus to support the embryo. Mifepristone (RU-486) is also an SPRM. ella is billed as an EC, even though it acts similar to RU-486. It is designed to be taken within 5 days of 'unprotected sex', and is thought to inhibit or delay ovulation in order to prevent fertilization. However, ovulation may have already occurred. ella can also alter the lining of the uterus, which will prevent an embryo from implanting, causing an abortion.

RU-486 - Mifeprex (The Abortion Pill): Mifeprex blocks the action of progesterone, which is needed to maintain the lining of the uterus and provide oxygen and nutrients for the child. Mifeprex is used with Cytotec (misoprostol). Cytotec causes uterine bleeding, which can be profuse, strong contractions and expulsion of the child. A woman receives the Mifeprex pills on the first visit, returns 2 days later for the misoprostol, and a third visit is required to verify that the abortion is complete. The 'failure' rate of this method is 8% at 7 weeks, and up to 23% at 8 or 9 weeks. If the child survives this abortion attempt, there is a higher risk of mental and/or physical birth defects from the misoprostol.

Hormonal Contraceptives: All hormonal contraceptives including the pill, mini pill, patch, vaginal ring, intrauterine device (IUD), or injection can work in one of 3 ways: prevent ovulation, prevent fertilization or prevent implantation. As stated earlier, the first 2 methods are contraceptive, but if they fail, the third method causes an abortion.

Risks and side effects from abortion include breast cancer, post-abortion grief which may result in emotional and physical disturbances (including depression, insomnia, nervousness, guilt and regret, alcohol and drug abuse, and suicidal thoughts), complications in future pregnancies (including excessive bleeding, premature delivery, placenta previa, retention of the placenta, cervical damage and sterility), pelvic inflammatory disease (PID), uterine perforations, and tubal (ectopic) pregnancy. Risks from hormonal birth control include blood clots, ectopic pregnancy, bacterial infections, increased susceptibility to the AIDS virus and increased risk of cervical and breast cancer. Studies have also shown an increase in sexually transmitted infection rates since EC became widely available. Sources: Human Life Alliance, 'Do you have an open mind?', and www.all.org
